OUTREACH INTENTION

Our Outreach Intentions for May and June Outreach will be **Racine's Baby Closet**

The St. Vincent de Paul baby closet is an initiative of the Mother Teresa, St. Vincent de Paul Conference which included Sacred Heart, St. Rita, St. Joseph and St. John parishes in Racine. Its purpose is to provide basic baby care items to women and families in emergency or crisis situations. All items are distributed through home visits. It is at the discretion of the home visitors (i.e. counselor, social worker, baby closet contact personnel) that items are given out. Presently there are a few families being mentored or "grandparented" and items are being given out on a monthly basis as needed. Mainly diapers and wipes. The goal of the program is always to help the families and mothers become independent and self-reliant. Currently the greatest needs are for diapers and pull-ups sizes 3 and larger and diaper wipes. Pastoral Passage by Heather Warner, Pastoral Assistant

Next weekend at Mass, we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, my favorite weekend in the Liturgical calendar. During my graduate studies, I spent a great deal of time studying Trinitarian Theology. Many would agree that Trinitarian doctrine is the hardest to express in human terms. I, however, found so much beauty in the images theologians conceived to explain this great mystery of our faith.

My favorite was imagined by the theologian Elizabeth Johnson who compares God (the Trinity) with DNA. The shape of DNA is a double helix: two strands of genetic material woven together to form the building block of all biological life. Now imagine DNA with an extra strand, Johnson describes - a triple helix that's the greatest source of life ever! That's what God (the Trinity) is like: three equal persons who together give life to everything. Three strands of love entwined around those who believe in a perfect relation!
