We know that He could provide immediate relief from our pain, but He is more concerned with dealing with the root of the problem. We may be afraid that He will reveal issues that we are unprepared or unwilling to deal with.

In times like these, it is helpful to remind ourselves that the Lord's discipline, though it may be painful, is wise, and His words are caring with love. God's purposes of love can be trusted more than any of our emotions of fear. May we surrender our hidden faults to the Lord, so that the beauty of Jesus can be seen in all of us!

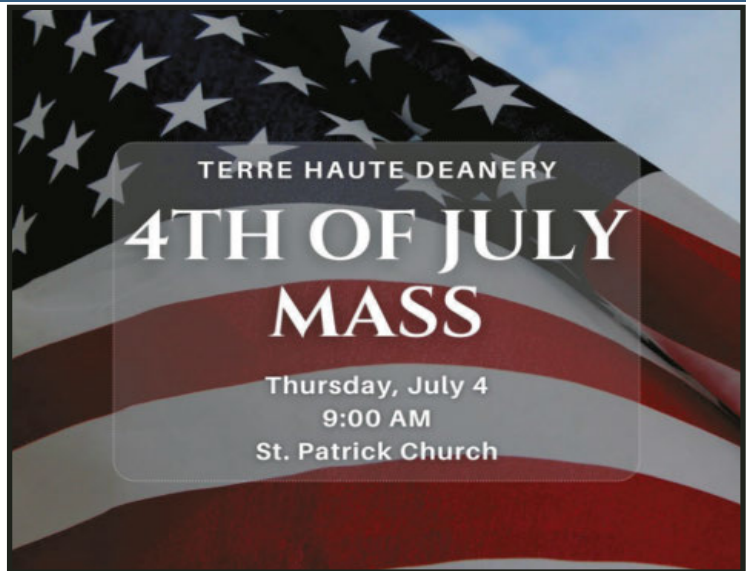

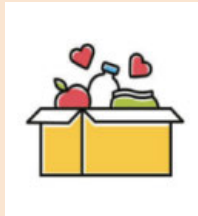

Carmelite Novena to Our Lady of Mount Carmel

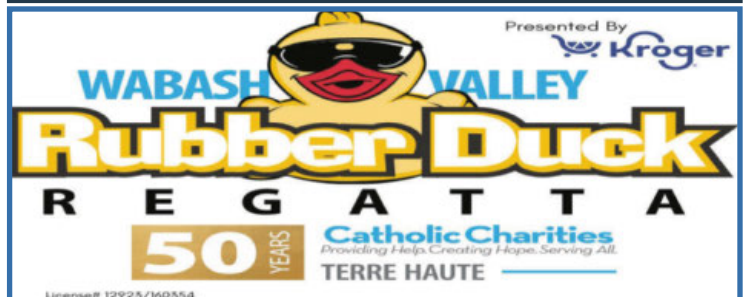
