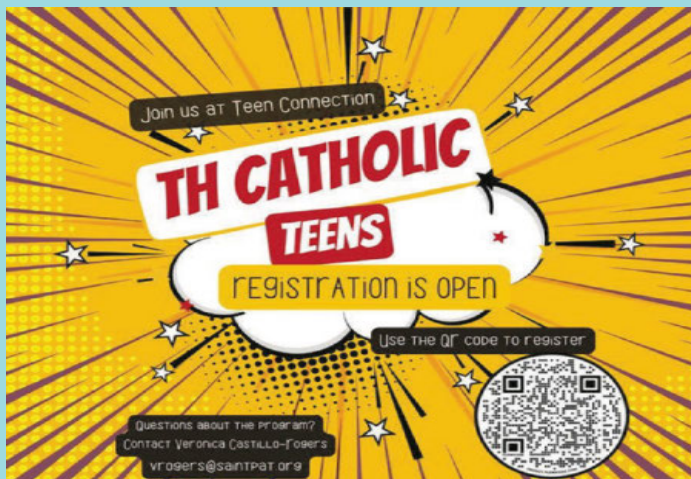
## Name Tag Masses

subject line "Room Reservation". It is my great hope that this opens communications between us all and provides clarification for future use. Thank you as always for your continued support of the parish and our staff.



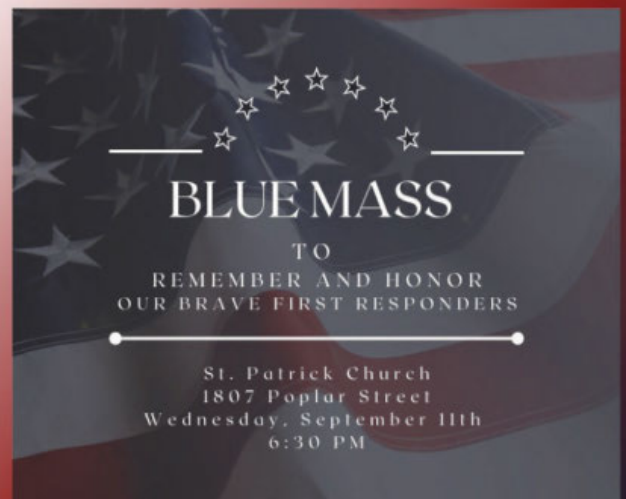
