Dear Fellow Parishioners ~

"To Shine Upon"

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. The word "Epiphany" is a Greek word meaning, "to shine upon," "to manifest," or "to make known." There is the ancient practice of blessing homes or churches with the traditional Epiphany blessing. The inscription "20 + C + M + B + 22," is inscribed on the overhead transom of doors in white chalk. The first two digits of the year plus "C + M + B" and the last two digits of the year, stand for the traditional names of the three Magi: "Casper, Melchior and Balthasar." The three letters can also mean: "Christus Mansionem Benedicat," a Latin phrase meaning, "Christ bless this home." There is also the ancient practice of chanting the proclamation of the movable feasts for the upcoming Church Year on the Feast of the Epiphany with the highlight being the great events of Holy Week and Easter.

These great traditions remind us that Jesus was manifested as Messiah and Lord in a threefold way: to the Magi, at his baptism at the Jordan River, and at the wedding feast of Cana. The Epiphany of the Lord celebrates the fullness of Christmas. Jesus was manifested to the Jewish people at his birth and to the Gentiles at his Epiphany. Today is our feast of Christmas! May we celebrate the wonder and joy of our salvation made present in the gift of Jesus.

St. Joseph & Immaculate Conception collects ink cartridges to recycle to be sent to "Empties4Cash". For cartridges to qualify for payment, they must be:

- * original manufacturer's brand such as HP, Canon, Collins or Epson only.
- * the print head can NOT be damaged, re-manufactured, refilled or ink tanks without heads.
- * Empties4Cash does NOT accept toners cartridges, Lexmark, Xerox or Brother.

There are collection boxes in both parishes or you can bring them to the office. The proceeds go to our general fund, help Faith Formation or any maintenance that needs to be done.


