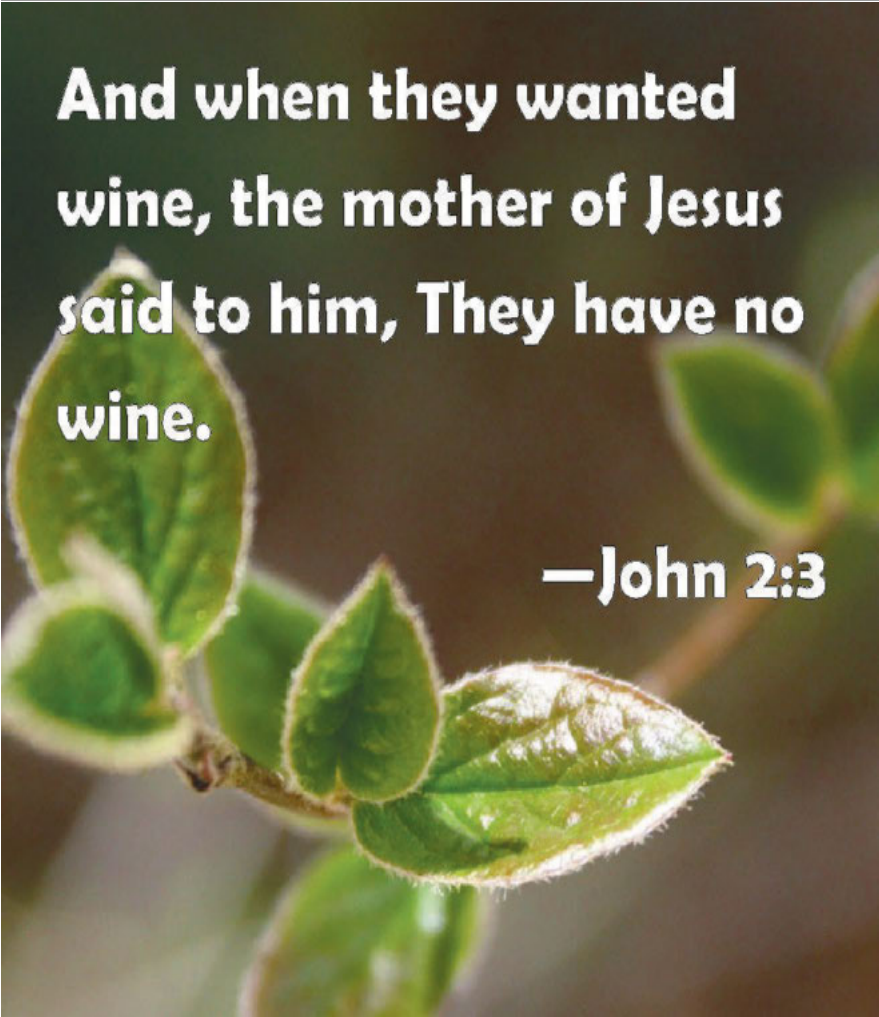

“Respect for Human Life”



On January 17, the Church celebrates the feast of St. Anthony of Egypt. He was born in 251 A.D. in upper Egypt to very affluent

Christian parents. As a young man he gave away all of his material possessions and went into the desert to live a life of prayer, penance and manual labor. Soon news of St. Anthony’s sanctity spread far and wide and hundreds of young men came to join him in living the monastic life in the wilderness. St. Anthony died in the year 356 A.D., at the age of 105. May we pray for all monastic women and men who live the Gospel in such a profound way.

Finally, on January 22, the Bishops of the United States have decreed as a “Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children.” This is the anniversary of the 1973 decision of the United States Supreme Court, that legalized abortion in our country. May we pray and do penance for respect for all human life, from conception to natural death.

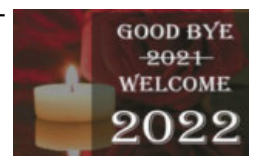

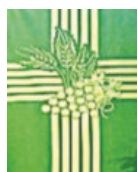

Ordinary Time



Ordinary Time is called "ordinary" because the weeks are numbered. The Latin word ordinalis, which refers to numbers in a series, stems from the Latin word ordo, from which we get the English word order. Thus, Ordinary Time is in fact the ordered life of the Church—the period in which we live our lives neither in feasting (as in the Christmas and Easter seasons) nor in more severe penance (as in Advent and Lent), but in watchfulness and expectation of the Second Coming of Christ.

There are two times we are in Ordinary Time. There are 28 weeks of Ordinary Time after Easter and 5 weeks of Ordinary Time after Christmas. However, this varies depending upon when Easter falls in a particular year. The actual number of weeks of Ordinary Time in any given year can total 33 or 34.
