Dear Fellow Parishioners ~

"St Paul - The Apostle"

On January 25, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul the Apostle. St. Paul was born in Tarsus in Cilicia to Jewish parents who were from the tribe of Benjamin, and he was also a Roman citizen. As a young man, he went to Jerusalem to study the ancient Jewish law at the feet of the famous rabbi Gamaliel. St. Paul returned to Tarsus before the public life of Jesus and shortly after the Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection. Eventually he returned to Jerusalem and joined in a fanatic persecution of the Early Church. The Acts of the Apostles note that he was present for the stoning of St. Stephen. The high priest of the temple charged him to go to Damascus to arrest Christians and bring them back to Jerusalem for trial.

As he neared the city of Damascus, at about noon, Jesus appeared to him in his glory and knocked him senseless to the ground. An immediate transformation occurred within the soul of St. Paul and the champion persecutor became the greatest missionary of the Gospel. He went on to serve the Church by bringing the Gospel message to the Gentiles during three main missionary journeys. May we too open our hearts to the transforming power of the Risen Christ in our lives.

Faith Formation Confirmation

Confirmation changes here at Saint Joseph and Immaculate Conception Parishes:

A few years ago where Confirmation is celebrated changed for many parishes in our diocese, ours included. You now have to have 50 or more students for the Bishop to come to your parish every year. There are only a handful of parishes that have that amount each year, so the diocese put parishes together to celebrate according to which vicarate you are in. Our two Parishes celebrated with Assumption Parish in Pulaski, St. Johns in Seymour, and two other parishes that Assumption is linked with.

The next year our two parishes went with St. Johns in Seymour sharing where the celebration would take place every other year. Both parishes used to have spring Confirmation, and we changed because Assumption in Pulaski did a fall Confirmation. Now that it looks like we

will continue to celebrate Confirmation with St. Johns in Seymour, we inquired about changing back to spring Confirmation.



We are being allowed to start celebration Spring Confirmation this year, May 22, 2022 at St. Joseph Parish 10:00am Mass; because the Bishops schedule is full, Father John Girotti will be doing the Confirmations along with Father Paul Paider. Our students will now Confirm in grade 11. Confirmation will now switch back and forth each year between St. Joseph Parish and St. Johns Parish for the celebration.

This year Immaculate Conception and St Joseph Parishes have done some programs together and we hope to continue that in the future.

Bishop's Appeal Pray & Question

Week 1: As we begin the Bishop's Appeal, let us pray for our many brothers and sisters who need our help through the Appeal. We pray to the Lord...

What is the Bishop's Appeal and where does my donation go?

The Bishop's Appeal is a direct appeal to people of the diocese to make a gift and support the mission and ministries of the Diocese of Green Bay. These ministries reach many different people in need. Young people learn about Jesus in our parishes and Catholic schools, those in need of counseling are helped at Catholic Charities, and pastoral care ministers are available to church members. Your gift to the Bishop's Appeal helps us build vibrant parishes and share the gospel throughout northeastern Wisconsin. The Bishop's Appeal kicks off in February.

Ordinary Time

Ordinary Time is called "ordinary" because the weeks are numbered. The Latin word ordinalis, which refers to numbers in a series, stems from the Latin word ordo, from which we get the English word order. Thus, Ordinary Time is in fact the ordered life of the Church—the period in which we live our lives neither in feasting (as in the Christmas and Easter seasons) nor in more severe penance (as in Advent and Lent), but in watchfulness and expectation of the Second Coming of Christ.



There are two times we are in Ordinary Time. There are 28 weeks of Ordinary Time after Easter and 5 weeks of Ordinary Time after Christmas. However, this varies depending upon when Easter falls in a particular year. The actual number of weeks of Ordinary Time in any given year can total 33 or 34.
