The Epiphany of the Lord

Matthew 2:1-12

"...do him homage."

We read the word "homage" three times in today's Gospel reading. The Magi searched for the newborn King of the

Jews so they could "come to do him homage." Homage can mean accolades, respect, or honor, but in medieval times it held a deeper meaning. A king's male subject could officially become the king's "man" by announcing allegiance to the monarch in a formal ceremony. In that ritual, known as homage, the subject knelt and placed his hands between those of his lord, symbolically surrendering himself and putting himself under the lord's jurisdiction. A bond was thus forged between the two; the man's part was to revere and serve his lord, and the lord's role was to protect the man and his family.

Connecting with everyday life: The bond between Jesus and the baptized is strong. He lovingly protects us and provides eternal salvation for our souls, but are we serving the Lord? Are we living our lives in a way where we do Him homage? Are we publicly showing our allegiance to Christ and His teachings? Do people know we are Christians by our love for Him and others? 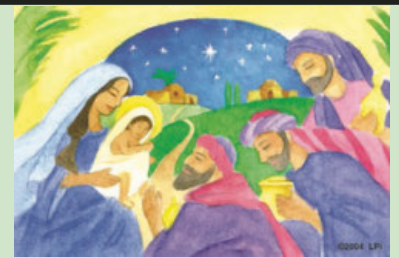

"Rendirle homenaje".

Leemos la palabra "homenaje"

tres veces en la lectura del Evangelio de hoy.

Los magos buscaron al recién nacido Rey de los judíos para poder "venid a rendirle homenaje". El homenaje puede significar elogios, respeto u honor, pero en la época medieval tenía un significado más profundo. El súbdito masculino de un rey podría convertirse oficialmente en el "hombre" del rey al anunciar su lealtad al monarca en una ceremonia formal. En ese ritual, conocido como homenaje, el sujeto se arrodilla y coloca sus manos entre las de su señor, entregándose simbólicamente y poniéndose bajo la jurisdicción del señor. Así se forjó un vínculo entre los dos; la parte del hombre era venerar y servir a su señor, y la función del señor era proteger al hombre y a su familia. Conexión con la vida cotidiana: El vínculo entre Jesús y los bautizados es fuerte. Él nos protege con amor y proporciona la salvación eterna para nuestras almas, pero ¿estamos sirviendo al Señor? ¿Estamos viviendo nuestras vidas de una manera en la que le rendimos homenaje? ¿Estamos mostrando públicamente nuestra lealtad a Cristo y sus enseñanzas? ¿Sabe la gente que somos cristianos por nuestro amor por él y por los demás? 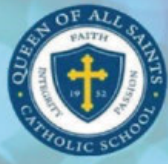

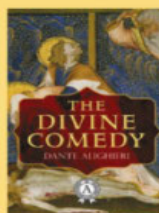

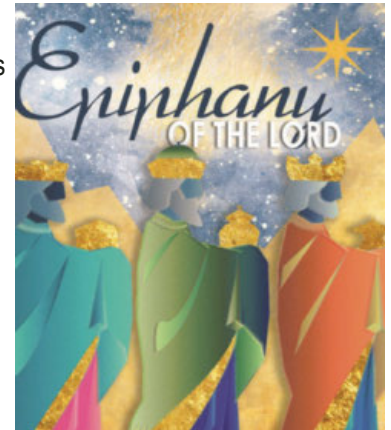

The Light of the Moon

If you own a television that has been turned on at any point in the last month or so, chances are you've caught at least a scene or two of the 1946 classic film "It's a Wonderful Life."



If you're not familiar with the movie, it follows the life of George Bailey from childhood through adulthood. A dreamer by nature, George has big plans for himself that involve world exploration and adventure — but family and community obligations keep him tethered to the same spot on the map, leading an altogether ordinary life.

One of the most memorable scenes from that movie is of George dancing with his sweetheart Mary while they sing "Buffalo Gals — Won't you come out tonight/And dance by the light of the moon?"

That lyric always catches my ear. Of course, the moon doesn't have any light of its own. All the moon has is the ability to reflect the light that shines upon it.

The same holds for us, doesn't it? Our stewardship is purely a reflection of the grace granted to us by another. "Upon you the LORD shines," writes Isaiah, "and over you appears his glory." Every good action we will ever take begins in the mind of God. The fact that we have the honor of carrying it out on His behalf is a beautiful gift. It is God that makes our ordinary lives extraordinary.

In the end of the movie, George Bailey realizes that he had a far greater life because, instead of being the hero of his own story, he allowed himself to reflect goodness onto others.

Remember — the magi didn't chart their own course. They merely followed the star.

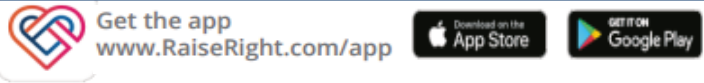

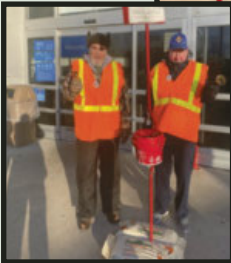

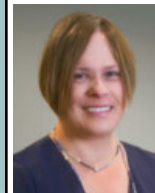
