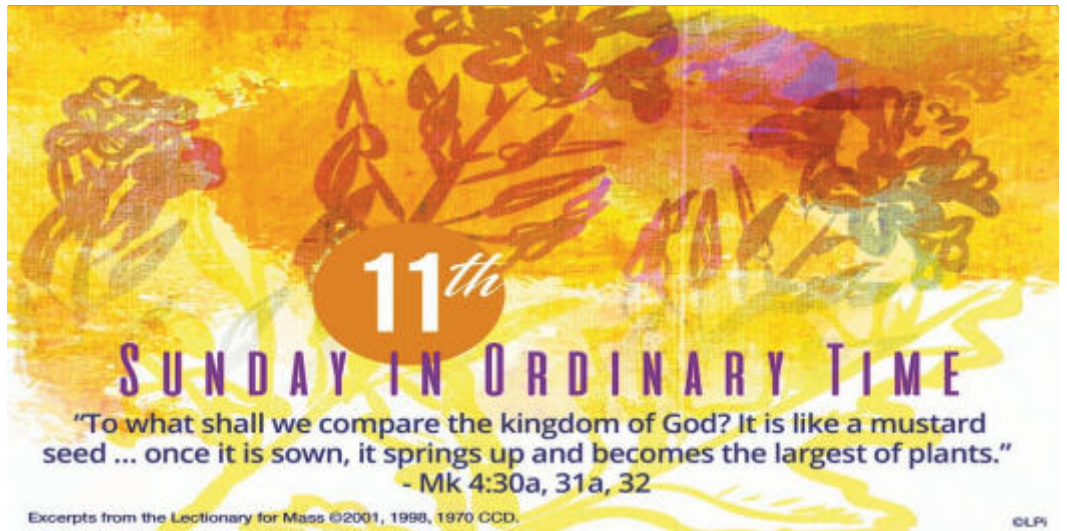

PRAYER & WORSHIP

A NOTE FROM DEACON MARK	MASS INTENTIONS
<p>A few weeks ago, I planted some grape vines in the backyard. This has been on the to-do list at our home for many years and it seemed this was the year to do it. Last spring, we had to have a damaged maple removed from the back yard and doing this allowed more sun to now enter in. Grapes need a lot of sun I am told. The plants arrived as bare root cultivars and did not look that special or give any special promise of great growth. Still, I planted them where we thought they would get the most sun and I put faith in the organic nursery in Vermont that sold them, believing they know more about this type of endeavor than I did. I planted, watered, and waited. To my surprise, after a few days, little buds of leaves started to grow and then another, and then another. It seemed these little plantings were very happy to be in soil again and were doing what they knew best, pushing new life up and out. I won't have grapes to harvest this year but like all things, patience is needed, as there will likely not be any fruit for another 3-4 years.</p> <p>Today's gospel is about planting and growth. A man sleeps and through it all the seed sprouts and grows; the man does not know how it happens. The kingdom of God grows often without our knowing until we start to see signs of its growth. The kingdom of God is not meant to be equated with heaven and in general is not a place.. The kingdom of God might be better equated with the term, "the reign of God," because this term better conveys the idea that the kingdom of God is about a time when God's power for good is fully manifested to the world and evil is defeated. Even though it seems that evil in the world is winning, God is working slowly, without our knowing, and His goodness and truth will triumph at the proper time, when we least expect it.</p> <p><u>Upon Further Reflection</u></p> <p>A Texan was visiting a friend who was a small Iowa farmer.
