PRAYER & WORSHIP

A NOTE FROM DEACON MARK	MASS INTENTIONS
<p>In our daily lives, many times we might hear of those who are sick and are need of prayers. Some might be seriously ill and at the point of death while others may suffer from a chronic illness for years and years. Today's gospel contains both situations. There is the sudden illness of a 12 year-old child which leads to her untimely death and the chronic illness of a woman with suffered from hemorrhages for 12 years. In both situations, we see Jesus healing presence. When Jairus approached Jesus in today's Gospel about his dying daughter, Jesus immediately became present to him and left with him to visit the child. On the way, someone hemorrhaging was healed simply by reaching out to touch Jesus cloak tassel with faith. Arriving at Jairus' house, Jesus was present to the apparently dead child and to her parents. In all cases, Jesus brought new life into dark situations through his mercy and compassion.</p> <p>Jesus is the example for us. We, too, are called to be present to others in their suffering. Consoling and comforting those in need are spiritual works of mercy and visiting the sick and dying is a corporal work of mercy. This "mystery of mercy" is supremely revealed in the life of Jesus, and, as Pope John Paul II taught us, it is our constant mission to proclaim and introduce that mercy into our daily life (Dives in Misericordia, 1980; #14). Coming to the aid of our neighbor in a time of need, both spiritual and physical, is a charitable action or "work of mercy" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, #2447). When we serve those who are hurting, we serve Christ who identifies with them (CCC #544).</p> <p>For the past year or so, I have felt a desire to pray more with others in their need. The pandemic disrupted parish life and ministry for a long while but it seems there is opportunity now to begin a simple prayer ministry at church. I spoke to Fr. Nonito before he left on vacation and he gave permission to begin. What this ministry will look like is that once a month after Mass, there will be an opportunity for people to come and ask for prayers for any concern they may have, including healing.</p> <p>I will lead a prayer ministry team after Mass, as we ask the Holy Spirit to be present with His healing love, power and mercy. 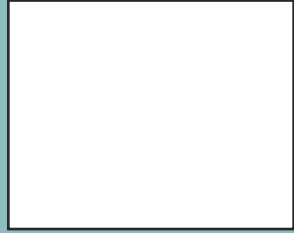
