PRAYER & WORSHIP

A NOTE FROM FR. HANZ

Jesus sent his disciples on a mission. Even though they would be away on this apostolate for a long time, he told them not to bring with them the important things that we depend on in our daily life. They could take a walking stick but no food, no money and no extra clothing. We think of these items as indispensable in our life. Much of our time and effort are spent in trying to acquire these same things and then to accumulate them even to excess.

Jesus wanted his apostles to recognize the true importance of worldly goods. They are good only for this world and only insofar as they contribute to the building up of the kingdom of God here on earth. If we have more than what we need, how shall we use that excess so that we may truly be part of the unfolding of God's Kingdom in history.

The apostles went out to the villages and towns and preached that men should repent. This really was not an easy mission. If you want to be unpopular, do not bring the important things that you depend on in your life. More than that, preach on a very unpopular topic, such as repentance. People can usually tolerate a speaker who expounds on such unpopular topics as repentance. After all, they can choose not to heed what is being said. They go back to their own affairs and set everything aside as though nothing was spoken.

How many preachings, sermons and homilies have we heard? Did we pay attention because the Holy Spirit was there trying to move us? Many times we have heard of the need to repent. Are we still waiting for the time when we will think about it? Maybe we did not refuse to hear but did we heed and take any action? What have we done up to now?

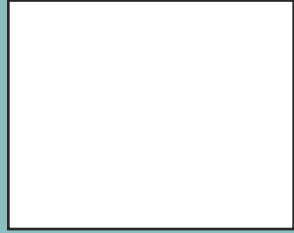
