A NOTE FROM FR. HANZ	MASS INTENTIONS
<p><i>Finally the apostles came back from their missions. They had enjoyed the work of preaching to the people and of curing the sick. It had been a continuous work and added to this, was the problem of hiking wherever they needed to go. They were tired but they were happy and eager to report to Jesus all that they had done. Our Lord saw that they needed rest and so he urged them to do just that. He was attentive to the moral support and their health. People who are busy giving their own physical and spiritual strength are liable to forget that we as humans need time and opportunity to recharge. Sometimes we need rest for our body; we also need rest and renewal for our spirit. Do we give proper attention to our needs to refresh our body and especially our soul? We will use these in the service of God. Are we attentive to the needs of others, the needs of their body and soul? They too will have to serve God.</i></p> <p><i>Even though Jesus and his apostles tried to leave the crowd so that they could have quiet and they could refresh themselves, the people still filled them. It would be a journey on foot but the people still wanted to hear the Word of God so they went along to the quiet place, too. Jesus broke the bread of the Word of God with them.</i></p> <p><i>Jesus' plan had been frustrated by the people. He had a dilemma. He knew that his apostles needed rest and recollection. He also knew that the people needed spiritual help. He did not get angry with the people of frustrating his plan and the labor involved in trying to reach the quiet place. He pitied them and spoke to them.</i></p> <p><i>When our plans are upset, do we become irritated? Do we become unpleasant and blame other people? 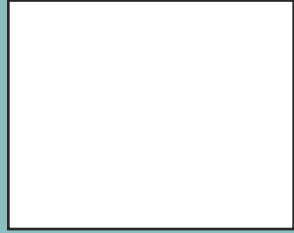
