PRAYER & WORSHIP

A NOTE FROM DEACON MARK

I like to walk! In fact, if you are driving on the roads around the Menominee Tribal Clinic during the work week, you would likely see me walking over my lunch hour. Sometimes I stop and say a prayer at the little shrine to Our Lady of Schoenstatt, located near the Keshena Falls bridge (future bulletin article?). This past May 2021, my wife and I walked 21 miles from the Shrine of St. Joseph, at St. Norbert's College, to the Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help in Champion, WI. A very moving spiritual experience and one without blisters on our feet! Someday, I might like to walk the Camino de Santiago, a pilgrimage of around 500 miles, starting in France and ending in the cathedral of Santiago de Compostela in Galicia, Spain. For me, there is something about being a pilgrim, praying and walking toward a holy place, that somehow brings one closer to God. Maybe it is because such walks remind us that we are truly pilgrims, making our steady path through life toward our goal of Heaven.

I cannot go to France and Spain this year but I will be going on a local pilgrimage called "The Wisconsin Way," September 11-14th. Established in 2013 by Fr. Andrew Kurz, "The Wisconsin Way" brings the experience of The Way of St. James (Camino de Santiago) to America, expanding pilgrims' access to the adventure and spiritual blessings of pilgrimage. Beginning the journey in Champion, pilgrims can experience the beauty and mystery of The Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help. Winding through the Wisconsin countryside, pilgrims experience the breathtaking wonder of God's creation. Each point connects a parish, chapel, shrine or monastery, allowing for prayer and devotion along the way.

Holy Hill provides the stunning destination for the end of the pilgrimage. The Basilica rises above the hills and forest of the Kettle Moraine to be seen for miles (wisconsinway.com)."

Now I must admit I will not be walking the whole journey (around 120 miles), as it is a supported pilgrimage with several van shuttles in between locations. Still, I wanted to share my upcoming pilgrimage with you, as I would be happy to pray for your intentions while walking "The Wisconsin Way." 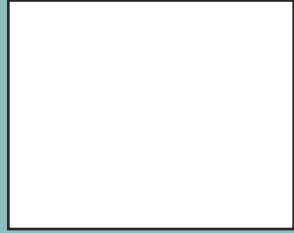
