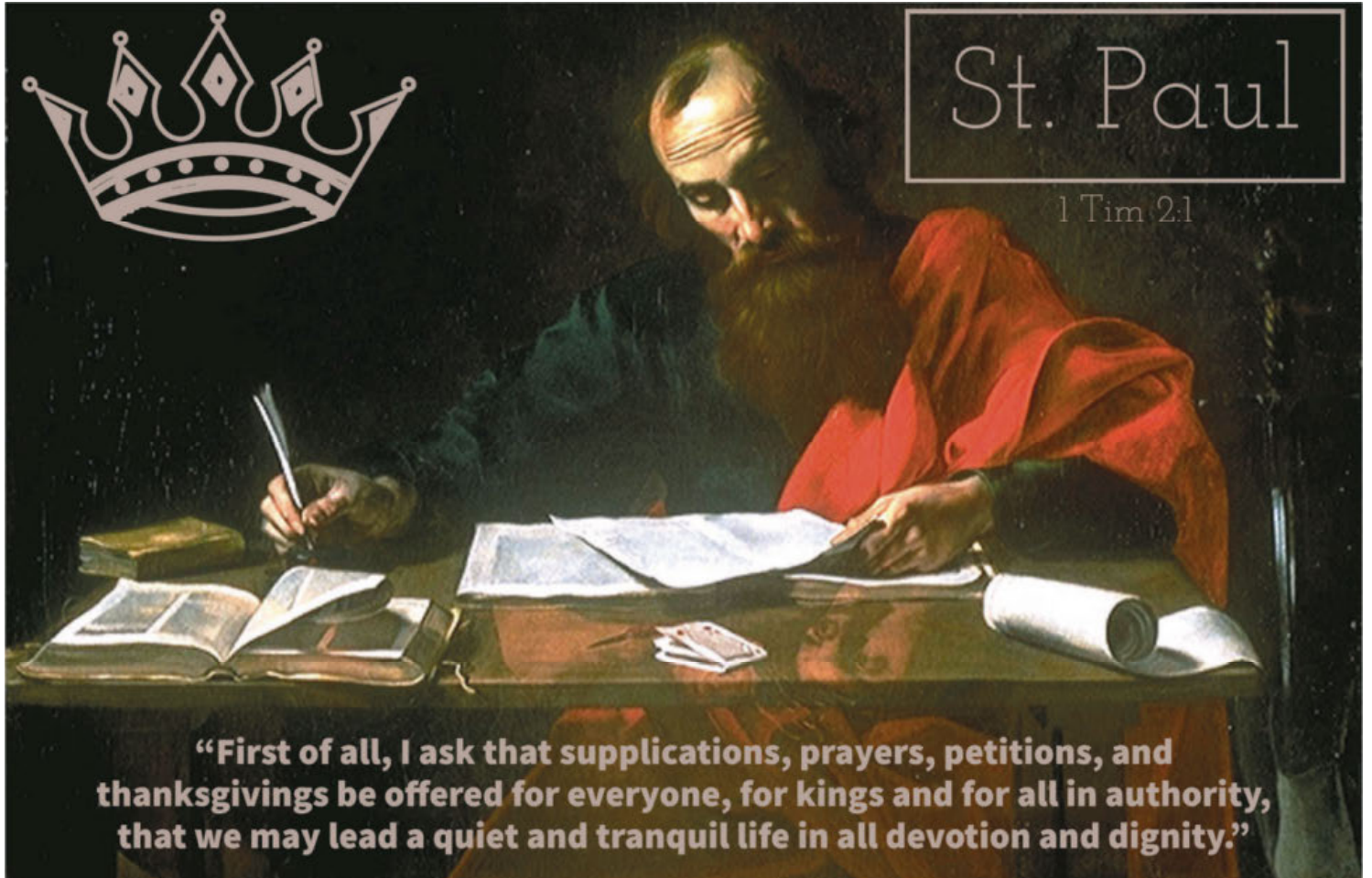

Our principal, Mr. Curt Julian, continues to recover from his health struggles. He will have a heart procedure and hopefully rejoin us at our schools shortly after. As mentioned last week, our schools are experiencing adequate leadership with the team of staff members who are leading our schools in his absence, along with assistance from diocesan team members. Mr. Julian continues to work from home. Please keep Mr. Julian and his family in your prayers.

Our schools are now preparing for some fall field trips. We want to take advantage of the good weather and the opportunity to learn about our local area. As of Monday, both of our schools will be fully staffed. At Holy Trinity, we are still in the midst of our search for a new Kindergarten teacher who will also have a role with 4K and First Communion.

MAPS testing (standardized testing) is already underway and our teachers will be able to identify specific areas they can help specific students with in the coming months. MAPS testing has been enhanced in both schools by the use of more new Chromebooks garnered through the continued use of COVID related funding.

Most important is that we continue to be "faith forward" in our schools. Ali Schanhofer has faithfully served the St. Mary School Board and will no longer be with us in this capacity. We thank her profusely! We will now seek another "faith forward" leader for our board.

"HOW GREAT IS OUR GOD!"

Thank you for your warm welcome! We are happy to be here! In case you want to know about us: both of us were raised in the northwestern suburbs of Chicago, and we met through a Catholic retreat called "Cursillo". Chuck was working as a project manager for Whirlpool; Eileen had taken a year off from working as a dietitian to do a year of service in Toledo. We were married on October 5, 1985. We have four children (ages from 34 to 28), two are married and have blessed us with eight grandchildren and one of the way. One lives in Virginia, one in Texas, and two in the area.

When our oldest son was four months old, Chuck quit his job to work for the Catholic Church, most often as a business manager. We have lived in West Dundee, IL; Rockford, IL; Woodstock, IL; Omaha, NE; and Appleton, WI. It seems like each time Chuck would look into beginning the diaconate formation, God would move us on to the next place. Looking back, maybe it was because God wanted us to settle here in the Green Bay Diocese. Chuck was ordained a deacon in May 2012, and two years later Bishop Ricken asked him to serve as pastoral coordinator at Holy Rosary, Kewaunee, and at St. Mary, Algoma.

You may know that Eileen's dad died a year ago, and this past spring her mom, Peg, came very close to dying several times. Chuck stayed in Kewaunee to work while Eileen stayed at her mom's beside in the hospital (in Illinois), but really it didn't look good. Almost overnight, Peg had gone from a very active lifestyle to being on oxygen and unable to walk. It was so sad, and often on her way home in the evening from the hospital to her parents empty house, Eileen would stop at Culvers for a hot fudge sundae.

Peg has made tremendous progress: she walks unassisted and only needs oxygen while sleeping. Many doctors have told us that they didn't think she would make it. We are absolutely thrilled to have this extra time with her! So on Labor Day, Eileen suggested that we go for one last sundae of summer. While eating our ice cream, Eileen said, "It was the worst of summers; it was the best of summers." Really it was the worst, and YET, God had given us our mom back for a little bit more time. On the way home the radio (which was turned off) burst out with the refrain from the song, "How Great Is Our God!" The three of us were amazed because no one had touched any dials but really that was the best way to end the summer, praising God for His goodness to us.
