## He was not the light, but came to testify to the light.

(John 1:8)

Monday, Dec 21 is the Winter Solstice – the darkest day of the year where night will be 14.5 hours. We are in the midst of the darkness. Precisely now is when nature itself is telling us of the need for light. Interestingly this year, tomorrow will have an alignment of Jupiter and Saturn on the solstice. They will nearly appear to be a single light in the sky. This alignment has not occurred in 800 years, and some have suggested a similar alignment may have been the ‘Star of Bethlehem.’ Whether a comet, a special star, or a planetary alignment, the need for light is real, not just naturally, but in our lives.

John the Baptist willingly acknowledged his need for the light. He equally acknowledged that he himself was not the light. He realized that the Light must come from outside him – from Jesus Christ, the Light of the world. Are we willing to be humble like John? Acknowledging our need for the Light of Christ and testifying to Him with the whole of our lives.

### Parish Year End Donations

The generosity and enduring support of *Holy Family* is evident in so many ways in our parish. You provide so that the whole of the parish and her many ministries may be funded to help build the Kingdom of God in our little bit of the vineyard. In ordinary times, you are liberal in your support of the parish. In these times, you have remained strong and truly sacrificial. I am deeply appreciative of all your offerings to Christ and the Church.

With that said, I wanted to bring to your attention that the parish is running slightly behind. Almost every year, Holy Family enters December slightly (3-5%) behind budget. This year, we are entering December behind to a greater extent. At the end of November, we are just over \$38,000 (11%) behind budget. I understand the situation around us is unsettling and can be scary. I know many have lost jobs and financial security is fragile. I am sympathetic and understand why giving may have had to be reduced. If you are truly unable, be at peace. The parish continues to be in a stable financial position. Yet, we are starting to have to make adjustments and will continue to do so to protect the long-term establishment of the parish.

Yet, I also know from past years, that many parishioners make substantial, calendar year-end gifts. Your year-end generosity makes a tremendous difference for the overall parish health. Please consider your particular situation, your divine blessings, and how God may be asking you to trust in Faith. Donations can be made on Faith Direct, in check, or in the offering basket at the church doors. Those who typically take required minimum distribution (RMD) from your IRA can still choose to process a qualified charitable distribution (QCD) from your IRA to benefit Holy Family or any other qualified charity. You have until 12/31 so contact your financial or accounting professional today. Thank you and God Bless you.

## Opening Song:

### First Reading: 2 Samuel 7:1-5, 8b-12, 14a, 16

When King David was settled in his palace, and the LORD had given him rest from his enemies on every side, he said to Nathan the prophet, “Here I am living in a house of cedar, while the ark of God dwells in a tent!” Nathan answered the king, “Go, do whatever you have in mind, for the LORD is with you.” But that night the LORD spoke to Nathan and said: “Go, tell my servant David, “Thus says the LORD: Should you build me a house to dwell in?”

“It was I who took you from the pasture and from the care of the flock to be commander of my people Israel. I have been with you wherever you went, and I have destroyed all your enemies before you. And I will make you famous like the great ones of the earth. I will fix a place for my people Israel; I will plant them so that they may dwell in their place without further disturbance. Neither shall the wicked continue to afflict them as they did of old, since the time I first appointed judges over my people Israel. I will give you rest from all your enemies. The LORD also reveals to you that he will establish a house for you. And when your time comes and you rest with your ancestors, I will raise up your heir after you, sprung from your loins, and I will make his kingdom firm. I will be a father

to him, and he shall be a son to me. Your house and your kingdom shall endure forever before me; your throne shall stand firm forever.”

### Gospel Reading: Luke 1:26-38

The angel Gabriel was sent from God to a town of Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man named Joseph, of the house of David, and the virgin’s name was Mary. And coming to her, he said, “Hail, full of grace! The Lord is with you.” But she was greatly troubled at what was said and pondered what sort of greeting this might be. Then the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God.

“Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name him Jesus. He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give him the throne of David his father, and he will rule over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end.” But Mary said to the angel, “How can this be, since I have no relations with a man?” And the angel said to her in reply, “The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore the child to be born will be called holy, the Son of God. And behold, Elizabeth, your relative, has also conceived a son in her old age, and this is the sixth month for her who was called barren; for nothing will be impossible for God.” Mary said, “Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word.” Then the angel departed from her.


