Dear Parishioners,

I first want to take this opportunity to thank Kim Danahey for making our Church look so beautiful this Christmas season! Kim always does a great job every Christmas and this year did not disappoint! Thank you Kim! As we begin a new calendar year, I thought it would be helpful to update you on various happenings and projects here at the parish:

Convent Update

My main priority and goal for the convent is to make it a source of revenue for our parish. We've done a lot of work on the inside of the building, updating bathrooms, and fixing a lot of water damage to make the building more attractive to potential renters. Until we're able to book a permanent renter (religious community, not-for-profit group, etc.) we plan to rent the convent for retreats to local parishes, schools, young adult groups, etc. I am in conversations with different groups and organizations to rent the building. Please pray that we find the right fit and gain some extra revenue from the building.

Elevator Update

We're getting closer to our elevator addition being completed! Construction should end in the couple of weeks or so and then we need to wait for the city to inspect the elevator and give us the all-clear to allow people on it. The project will not be 100% finished until the Spring, when the new cement walkway is poured in the courtyard and the landscaping is done. We're still finishing up fundraising, so if you have not yet made your donation you can drop it off in the rectory office, collection basket, or make your donation online. Many thanks to everyone who has already donated to this necessary and important addition to our parish. I can't wait to open it up for people to use!

School Update

St. Edward School is going strong and continuing our mission of forming faithful citizens and intentional disciples of Jesus. In just a few weeks we will celebrate Catholic Schools Week with a kickoff Mass and Open House on Sunday, January 30. St. Edward School offers the best education on the Northwest Side where we form the whole child in academics, social-emotional skills, spirituality, and love of neighbor. If you or someone you know is looking to give their child the very best, come to our Open House on January 30! You can always contact our principal, Sara Lasica, to set up a private tour and ask any questions you may have. There are plenty of scholarship opportunities through the Illinois Tax Credit Scholarship program, Archdiocese programs, and our own scholarship programs.

Renew My Church

As many of you know, the Cardinal did not merge St. Edward with any of the parishes we were grouped in during *Renew My Church*. Part of the final decision though was to split the assets of Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish between St. Edward and Our Lady of Mercy Parishes. The Archdiocese is still in the process of formally closing IHM and relegating it to be sold. I will let you know when the property is put on the market. Once the campus is sold and all outstanding expenses paid, St. Edward will receive 50% of all assets left. It is my plan to put that money toward air conditioning our Church and Unity Hall. Hopefully it will be enough to outright pay for the air conditioning and we won't need to fundraise at all. I will continue to keep you all updated as the Archdiocese moves forward with selling the property. Also, FYI, the Archdiocese has a Department of Real Estate that takes care of these matters. Fr. Nick (pastor of Our Lady of Mercy) and I do not sell the property on our own.

I think that is all to update you on. I hope you all continue to have a very Merry Christmas and a Blessed New Years!

FEAST DAYS: Bus service will also be available for certain feast days and holy days of obligation. Call the rectory office at 773-545-6496 for times and information.

FEES: There is no cost to ride. Donations are always welcome to pay for gas.

GENERAL PROCEDURES:

- Our bus is equipped with an elevator lift and two wheelchair spaces. Please note our church building will not be accessible by wheelchair until the Fall of 2021.
- Anyone who would like a ride to Mass must call the rectory office at 773-545-6496 by 5:00 pm Thursday to reserve their seat for that weekend.
- Because of COVID restrictions, passengers are limited to a max of seven (7) and everyone must wear a mask on the bus at all times. When restrictions are lifted, the passenger capacity is fourteen (14). Spots will be assigned on a first-call, first-served basis each week.

TRANSPORTATION VOLUNTEERS: All our bus drivers have valid and up-to-date driver's licenses and are insured by the Archdiocese of Chicago. All our drivers are volunteers who are sacrificing personal and family time to participate in this ministry, please be understanding and patient with them. If there are any issues, please contact the rectory office.
