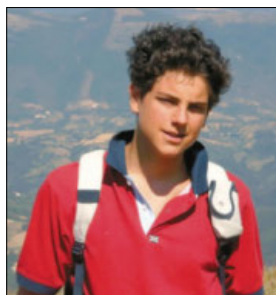

**MIRACLES OF THE EUCHARIST
 ACROSS THE WORLD**

**Resurrection hosting traveling exhibit
 from June 14 - June 28**



Blessed Carlo Acutis

*The information below comes from the website MiracoliEucaristici.org, Panel A, which contains an introduction, written by His Excellency Card. Angelo Comastri, that was included in the *Miracles of the Eucharist Across the World* exhibit. Resurrection will host parts of this exhibit periodically during the next year.*

Blessed Carlo Acutis, who died from leukemia in 2006 at the age of 15, had one plan in his life: to live with Jesus, for Jesus, and in Jesus.

Carlo once said, "Our destination must be what is infinite, not what is finite. Infinity is our homeland. We have been expected in Heaven since time immemorial".

The keys to moving toward this destination, he said, are the Sacraments and prayer. Carlo especially valued the Sacrament of the Eucharist, calling it "my highway to Heaven".

After receiving his First Communion at the age of 7, Carlo never missed daily Mass and always prayed the rosary. He also liked to practice Eucharistic Adoration because he was convinced that "by standing before the Eucharistic Christ, we become holy".

Carlo never understood why churches weren't overflowing with people waiting to see the Eucharistic Christ. We are lucky, he said, because 2000 years ago people had to travel constantly to see Christ. We are blessed because we can find Him in any church close to our homes, Carlo explained.

"Jerusalem is right on our doorstep," Carlo once said.

In Carlo's brief life, including his time spent as a catechist for younger children, he always tried his best to find new ways to help others strengthen their faith. So with this in mind, he created a series of exhibitions before his death, including one titled *Miracles of the*

Eucharist Across the World. Carlo and his family spent two and half years completing this demanding project, which has now impacted people across the globe.

In the United States alone, the exhibit has been hosted in thousands of parishes and more than 100 universities. The exhibit also has reached all five continents.

The exhibit highlights approximately 250 Eucharistic miracles recognized by the Church that took place around the world from the 4th Century all the way to 2013.

As part of the Diocese of Evansville's Eucharistic Renewal, the traveling Eucharistic Miracles exhibit will make its way through all the parishes in the diocese.

Resurrection will receive a portion of the exhibit approximately every two months for the next year. The first "set" in this traveling exhibit will arrive June 14th and remain through June 28th. We plan to display the exhibit in the Narthex.
