# **HEARING GOD'S CALL**

Nearly 60 students from Resurrection and St. Joe experienced Vocation Bible School this week









Jesus doesn't use a megaphone to call us. Instead, Jesus typically whispers His call. Jesus uses a soft voice because first He wants to be close to us! When we are close to Jesus, then we can hear His call.

This is a lesson Resurrection and St. Joe students learned on Day 1 of Vocation Bible School. This year Resurrection partnered with St. Joe to offer a new kind of Bible School. We utilized a Catholic-based program from Discovery Mission that was recommended by the Diocese of Evansville's Director of Vocations, Father Tyler Tenbarge.

God is Good Vacation Bible School and Vianney Vocations developed the program together. While this program had a meaningful Catholic message, it was also fast paced and fun.

Throughout the week, nearly 60 children visited art stations, game stations, prayer stations, and learned songs and dances.

When learning about Magnificent Marriage, students teamed up as "couples" to navigate an obstacle course with marriage milestones, made heart-shaped keychain rings for special couples in their lives, and "met" married couple St. Isidore and St. Maria. On day 3, Bible School students learned about the Powerful Priesthood by creating priestly prints depicting a chalice, vestment, and collar. The children learned the different priestly powers during the "Priestly Spud" ball game, and continued their lesson by studying about St. Junipero Serra. On the final day of Bible School, students explored Radiant Religious Life by creating prayer cards for sisters and brothers, by throwing balls into high-scoring buckets containing Bible verses, and by "meeting" St. Scholastica and St. Benedict and praying before the Blessed Sacrament.

Vocation Bible School aimed to offer children the following lessons: 1. God made you to be happy, and He loves you and has a plan for your life. 2. That plan for your life is your vocation. 3. The main Catholic vocations are marriage, priesthood, and religious life. 4. You can discover your


