From the desk of Fr. Sudhakar... Is Christ Calling You? By Deacon John McMullen and Deacon Tom Evans: God is calling on each of us to serve one another in charity and love. Some married and single men are receiving a particular invitation from God to serve Christ and His Church in ordained ministry as Permanent Deacons. Deacons have a unique identity as neither a lay person nor a priest. Through the sacramental grace of Holy Orders, deacons are conformed into the image of Christ the Servant. In communion with Bishop Siegel and his body of priests, deacons serve to build up the community of faith among God's people through Word, sacrament and especially works of charity. Our diocesan permanent deacons have greatly enriched our diocese by offering their lives in service in many of our parishes, hospitals, correction facilities and nursing homes as well as through outreach ministries to the homeless, the poor and hungry and the lonely and through many other ministries of charity. In response to the need for more deacons, Bishop Siegel has authorized the recruitment of a new class of permanent deacon candidates to begin their 4-year academic formation in September 2022. Perhaps, someone has said to you, "Did you ever think about becoming a deacon?" Or maybe the thought of becoming a deacon is regularly coming to you. So, how should you respond to these promptings? We suggest that you pray for guidance from the Holy Spirit, and seek guidance from your pastor, your wife, your family and your fellow parishioners. Beginning in September 2021, the Evansville Diocese Office of the Permanent Diaconate will also be organizing informational meetings in each of our 4 Deaneries. Locations and dates will be announced in the coming weeks in *The Message*, and in your parish bulletins. Dn Cletus Yochum Jr, will be having an inquiry session in St. Peter school basement, Montgomery at 7:00 pm on Thursday, 28<sup>th</sup>. All those who are aspiring to be an Ordained Deacons are most welcome to attend this session. Even if you have any questions on this, please come and you will have answers.
