

I come to you with a heart filled with joy, as I am taking this opportunity to announce to you the Opening of the New St. Joseph Church Building in my home Village in Nigeria on Sunday, April 25, 2021 at 1 pm (Nigerian Time) which is 7 am (Chicago Time), with the celebration of Mass of Thanksgiving by Most Reverend Camillus Umoh, Bishop of Ikot Ekpene Diocese, Nigeria. In deep gratitude for your generosity, my people insisted that we wait until afternoon at 1 pm, to have this Mass to make it possible for you to join us live. A link will be made available in our Parish Bulletin later. I thank you, my dear people of St. Thomas the Apostle Parish, and friends from my previous Parishes for your prayers, your goodwill and for your immense generosity in building this magnificent edifice for the honor and glory of God. Bishop Camillus Umoh imparts his Apostolic Blessing on each and every one of your family. He told me to extend his personal invitation to any of you who would want to come and visit, to know that you are most welcomed.

My joy, I must confess, is tempered with the fact that I will not be going home with ALL OF YOU, to come and see the Church you have built and visit with my people. To be certain, many wanted to go but with the Covid-19 situation and other factors beyond their control, have postponed their plans. I thank them for having wanted to go. A few of our parishioners are going with me. They are in the process of obtaining Travel Visa to Nigeria. The process, among other requirements, involves them traveling to the Nigerian Embassy in Washington DC for an interview. I am so grateful to them for making this effort to be able to come with me to witness the opening of the new Church Building and to represent you. I cannot be happier for their presence. Please pray for our journey to Nigeria and WE WILL BE BACK!

Starting March 10 we will be reciting the Litany of St. Joseph at all Masses till his Feast Day on March 19



St. Joseph was an ordinary manual laborer although descended from the royal house of David. In the designs of Providence he was destined to become the spouse of the Mother of God. His high privilege is expressed in a single phrase, "Foster-father of Jesus." About him Sacred Scripture has little more to say than that he was a just man - an expression which indicates how faithfully he fulfilled his high trust of protecting and guarding God's greatest treasures upon earth, Jesus and Mary. The darkest hours of his life may well have been those when he first learned of Mary's pregnancy; but precisely in this time of trial Joseph showed himself great. His suffering, which likewise formed a part of the work of the redemption, was not without great providential import: Joseph was to be, for all times, the trustworthy witness of the Messiah's virgin birth. After this, he modestly retires into the background of holy Scripture. Of St. Joseph's death the Bible tells us nothing. There are indications, however, that he died before the beginning of Christ's public life. His was the most beautiful death that one could have, in the arms of Jesus and Mary. Humbly and unknown, he passed his years at Nazareth, silent and almost forgotten he remained in the background through centuries of Church history. Only in more recent times has he been accorded greater honor. Liturgical veneration of St. Joseph began in the fifteenth century, fostered by Sts. Brigid of Sweden and Bernadine of Siena. St. Teresa, too, did much to further his cult. At present there are two major feasts in his honor. On March 19 our veneration is directed to him personally and to his part in the work of redemption, while on May 1 we honor him as the patron of workmen throughout the world and as our guide in the difficult matter of establishing equitable norms regarding obligations and rights in the social order.


