

Pastor's Corner

This weekend we celebrate the beginning of Catholic Schools Week. As we celebrate the 100th Anniversary Year of St. Thomas the Apostle Parish, we must also celebrate the fact that St. Thomas the Apostle Elementary School has been part of our history since the earliest days of our existence. I trust and pray that we all recognize what a gift and blessing this has been not only to our parish, but also to the larger community.



Catholic schools stand for a specific way of looking at life. We must more boldly embrace the opportunity they offer us to stand for something distinctive. We must all be committed to ensuring that our Catholic schools are places where the uniqueness of each child will be developed and celebrated, within an environment where God can be encountered. We must desire our Catholic schools to be places where Jesus is clearly present, and His Gospel Values are taught and modeled in all activities and relationships.

Unfortunately, there are dark forces at work in our society that want to get rid of any role for faith in public life, and especially in schools. There have been dark forces at work within society that encourage our schools to talk about almost everything, except for making references to God. The message goes out that you can believe anything you want, but that religious beliefs should be avoided. The implication is that faith is little more than a private hobby that one should keep to themselves.

Yet, this goes against the primary mission of our Church, which is Jesus' command not only to hear and take in His Gospel message, but also to proclaim it to others, with our words, our attitudes and our actions. If this is the primary mission of our Catholic Faith, then it also must be the primary mission of our Catholic schools!

Excellence in education is not in contradiction to this primary mission. We should be committed to ensuring that our students excel in all subjects. We just need to ensure that our Lord's Gospel Values are part of every classroom and activity at St. Thomas the Apostle. If our children know that their lives are precious gifts from God, and that they are loved and valued (both by God and this faith community), then the chances of them excelling in all their classes should dramatically improve.

If we can successfully instill the love of Jesus and His Gospel Values in our children, then we can be assured that they will very likely become responsible Catholic Servant Leaders for a world that desperately needs such guidance. There are great challenges facing the world and our families today. I believe our Catholic schools provide our families an opportunity to better face these many challenges.

I ask for your prayers this week for Catholic schools in general, but especially for St. Thomas the Apostle Catholic School. May we continue to grow stronger in our commitment to Faith, Excellence and Service! We thank God for the blessing that St. Thomas the Apostle School has been to this community and the great promise it offers our future!



Jesus is the Messiah who institutes a new covenant with his people, but he was raised as a practicing Jew by his devout parents. 

SAINT OF THE WEEK

You may be familiar with the annual "blessing of throats" that many parishes in the United States use to commemorate the beloved bishop and martyr. St. Blaise lived in the fourth century in Turkey and Armenia. Due to religious persecution, he was forced to flee and hide in a cave in the back country in order to save his life.

History has it that one day a group of hunters stumbled upon where St. Blaise was living. They found the bishop kneeling in prayer, surrounded by wolves, lions and bears that he had tamed. The legend has it that as the hunters dragged Blaise off to prison, a mother came with her young son who had a fish bone lodged in his throat. At Blaise's command, the child was able to cough up the bone and thus lived.

Today we remember the saint on his feast day by taking two candles, crossing them against the throat, and saying the following prayer:

Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

GOSPEL MEDITATION

ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

St. Oscar Romero (1917-1980) was a "Salvadoran Roman Catholic archbishop who was a vocal critic of the violent activities of government armed forces, rightwing groups, and leftist guerrillas conflict (Encyclopedia Britannica)." As a voice of the voiceless, he was an outspoken champion of the poor who were the ones most affected by the civil unrest and violence. His advocacy provoked everal attempts on his life. Nonetheless, St. Oscar Romero was convinced that before all els his faith in the resurrected Christ and the values of the Gospel trumped any earthly concern or worry. He walked with complete confidence and trust. On March 24, 1980, St. Oscar Romero was ssassinated while celebrating Mass. Such is often the fate of those who challenge the socio political agendas of the day.

We may look at the example of witness of St. Oscar Romero as something extraordinary. In one sense it is. Through the power of Cod, an ordinary human being did extraordinary things. But, in and of himself, St. Oscar Romero was simply a humble, loving



servant of Cod. Oscar knew not only the power of love but the risk that comes when loving unconditionally. The beauty of Cod's message was able to shine in and through him because he was able to step out of the way and be a vessel. One can assume that for St. Oscar Romero, one's earthly life has no merit when faith, integrity, conviction, zeal and love are jettisoned. Fear and apprehension had no grip on this man who not only saw but spoke the truth.

Do we speak the truth? It makes us feel good to speak of God as

love. But have we ever considered the ramifications of this radical message? There are assaults on human life occurring daily. More and more the value and worth of a human being is being reduced and minimalized. We are becoming widgets in the production of life. In our whole simple humble ways, we too are called to be prophets. Knowing who you are and what is within your means to do, how can you make God's love real, stand up for what is right, and give witness to dness of all that is around

Ser cristiano es ser un profeta comprometido en el amor y en la esperanza. La Liturgia de hoy, por medio del profeta Jeremías, nos pone en alerta sobre este asunto del llamado de Dios al discipulado ya desde el vientre materno: "Antes de formarte en el seno de tu madre, ya te conocía; antes de que tú nacieras, yo te consagré, y te destiné a ser profeta de las naciones" (Jeremías 1,5). Para comprender con mayor claridad y poner manos a la obra en este llamado, debemos recordar que, el domingo pasado, Jesús se encontraba en la sinagoga de Nazaret y sus últimas palabas del pasaje de la Escritura decían: "Hoy se cumplen estas palabras proféticas y a ustedes les llegan noticias de ello" (Lucas 4,21).

Los que escuchaban a Jesús se admiraban de su elocuencia. ¡No lo podían creer! Ellos lo conocían, habían vivido a su alrededor, tenían familiaridad con él. Por lo menos sabían su oficio, "carpintero, hijo de José y María". Jesús conocía sus pensamientos y responde: "Seguramente ustedes me van a recordar el dicho: Medico, cúrate a ti mismo. Realiza también aquí, en tu patria, lo que nos cuentan que hiciste en Cafarnaúm" (Lucas 4,23). ¿Por qué nadie es profeta en su tierra? Le pasó a Jesús y nos pasa muchas veces a nosotros, hacemos el bien por ahí y cuando se dan cuenta los vecinos y la familia, viene el cuestionamiento y los comentarios sin saber realmente lo que la persona es, vive, o siente. O, mejor dicho, se ignora su compromiso con el amor, como lo expresa San Pablo a los Corintios: "Ahora, pues, son válidas la fe, la esperanza y el amor: pero la mayor de estas tres es el amor" (1 Corintios 13,13)....©LPi
