From the Pastor's Desk...



In just three weeks, we will be celebrating a special 100th Anniversary Mass with Bishop David Malloy! The Mass will be offered on Saturday, July 2, at 4:30 p.m., with a reception to follow in the Community Room. Past pastors, Fr. Geoff Wirth and Msgr. Dan Hermes are planning to come back for this special Mass. Fr. Evans is also hoping to attend, if he can find coverage. Invitations have been sent to all the priests who have served here at St. Thomas over the years. It promises to be a special evening.

Last month, I wrote about Fr. Leo Ambre and the construction of our Oak Street Church. After Fr. Ambre left St. Thomas in March of 1980, we welcomed Fr. James McKittrick and Fr. Sam Guagliardo as co pastors, until October 1980, when Fr. Guagliardo was installed as Pastor. Assisting Fr. Guagliardo were; Rev. Donald Smithes, Rev. R. Kearney, Rev.

Thomas Brantman, Deacon Dan Hurley and Deacon Robert Nebel. Fr. Guagliardo remained with St. Thomas until August 1987. Fr. Guagliardo and Fr. McKittrick are now both retired and living respectively in Rockford and Fontana, Wisconsin.

St. Thomas welcomed Fr. Geoff Wirth in August 1987, and a period of renovations and expansion soon were planned for the growing parish. In the spring of 1988, the 26-year-old church received an extensive renovation and cleaning. In September 1989, a newly renovated parish center was blessed (our current parish center). Ground was broken in October 1994 for a new addition to the school on King Street (connecting it to the school on Lake Street) and a new community room at the Oak Street Church. In February of 1999, the Oak Street Church basement was renovated. In November 1999, a granite monument titled "To Life" featuring the Holy Family and two granite benches with the words "Respect Life" were installed (funded by the Knights) and blessed by Fr. Wirth. In February of 2000, work began on the repair and painting of the Pierson Street Church. In January of 2001, construction began on a new Baptismal pool at Oak Street. Many priests served as associates during this time, including the newly ordained Fr. Bob Jones. Yes, I was blessed to call this my first home as a priest, serving from 1992 to 1995.

Msgr. Dan Hermes became pastor in July 2001. In February 2002, the sanctuary space was returned to its original 1968 configuration. The changes were in keeping with the 2000 National Conference of Bishops document titled "Built of Living Stones." A new Crucifix graced our sanctuary and the Christ of Salvation was moved to the gathering area. A one-of-a-kind Chandelier pipe organ was acquired to enhance the 21-rank pipe organ built in 1974, making it the largest pipe organ in McHenry County. There was also a great amount of maintenance done over at the school and the Pierson Street Church. The growing Hispanic community under the leadership of Fr. William Tunarosa contributed greatly to the Pierson Street Church renovation. The Holy Hearts Adoration Chapel and Little Saints Preschool were also added during the pastorate of Msgr. Hermes. Msgr. Hermes had many priests that served as associates, including Fr. Tunarosa, who is still here, and Fr. Jerome Koutnick and Fr. Akan Simon, who were with Msgr. Hermes for a decade of service.

Fr. John Evans came to St. Thomas in 2018, after the retirement of Msgr. Hermes, and Fr. Charles Fitzpatrick came to St. Thomas in 2019, when Fr. Koutnik took a new assignment in Huntley. I am very grateful to Fr. Evans, the St. Thomas Staff and a dedicated flock to keeping the parish going through the world-wide Covid 19 pandemic that hit early in 2020. I am also grateful to the warm welcome you have extended to Fr. Andrew Hernandez and myself, as we began our service here just one year ago. It is an honor to be your pastor as we celebrate this milestone in our parish history.

Blessed Jolenta of Poland | June 12

Sometimes called Yolanda of Poland or Helen of Poland (or Hungary), Blessed Jolenta was the daughter of Bela IV King of Hungary and sister of St. Kunigunde, Queen of Poland. Her distinguished family tree includes St. Hedwig, St. Elizabeth of Hungary, and St. Margaret of Hungary.

Jolenta married Boleslaus, Duke of Greater Poland, who was later known as “The Pius” for the good works he would do. Together they founded hospitals, convents, and churches, using their wealth and position to serve others. After her husband died and two of her daughters were married, Jolenta and her youngest daughter joined the Poor Clares at Sandec. War caused Blessed Jolenta to move to a convent she and her late husband had founded in Gniezno, where she became Abbess.

Blessed Jolenta had a vision of Christ who told her of her approaching death. She was beatified in 1827.

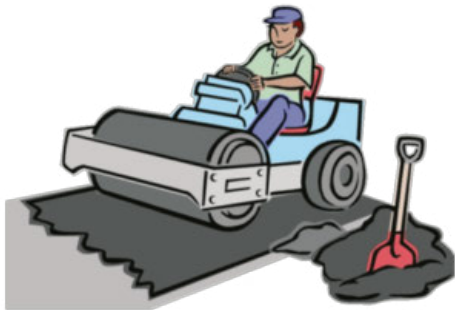

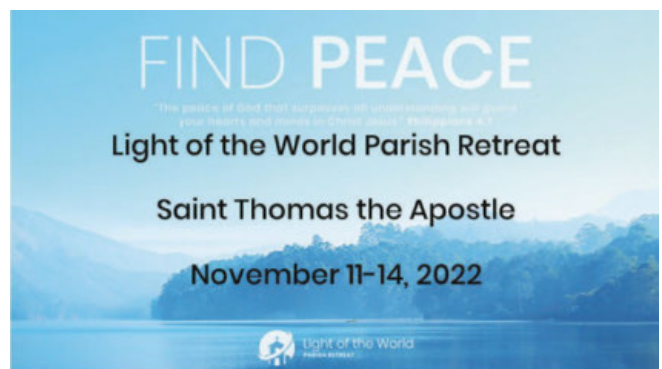

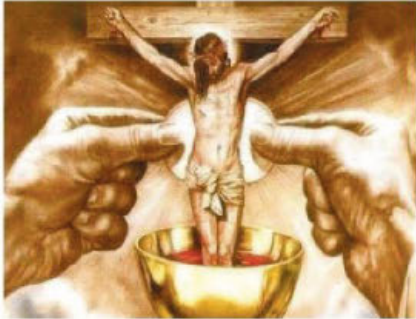
