



From the Pastor's Desk...



The National Eucharistic Revival officially begins on Corpus Christi Sunday, June 19, 2022. The Revival is a three-year initiative sponsored by the Bishops of the United States intended to form, heal, convert, and unite the People of God through a renewed encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist. From there it's focus becomes sending out these "Eucharistic missionaries" to a hurting and hungry world. Bishop David Malloy and the Diocese of Rockford will join in the opening of this revival on June 19, with the celebration of Mass at 11:00 a.m. at the Cathedral of St. Peter, Rockford followed by a Eucharistic procession from the Cathedral to the Our Lady of Guadalupe Prayer Garden for prayer and adoration. The milestone event of the Revival will be a National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, IN, from July 17-21, 2024.

The National Eucharistic Revival and National Eucharistic Congress are a direct response to the Holy Father's call for a "pastoral and missionary conversion which cannot leave things as they presently are," so that the Church in the United States might be "permanently in a state of mission" (Evangelii Gaudium, n.25).

- Visit the Eucharistic Revival website for updates and resources, as well as to sign-up for "The Heart of the Revival" Newsletter and to become a Prayer Partner.
- If you have not already done so, purchase a subscription *The Observer* in print and/or online for diocesan updates and activities related to the diocesan phase of the National Eucharistic Revival. There will also be teaching on the revival from Bishop Malloy's weekly column and in the new column about the Eucharist by Father Jonathan Bakkelund, of the Office for Divine Worship.
- Follow the Diocese of Rockford on Facebook and Twitter for updates and information as well as on the Diocese of Rockford website www.rockforddiocese.org.

I would like to conclude this column with a prayer that recently was given to me by a parish family of St. Thomas. They discovered the prayer at a parish where it is recited at every Mass before people receive the Eucharist. So, I would like to share it with you on this Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

"Oh Lord, I believe and profess that you are truly Christ, Son of the living God, who came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am first. Accept me this day as a partaker of your mystical supper O Son of God. May the partaking of your holy mysteries, O Lord, be not for judgment or condemnation, but for the healing of body and soul. I also believe and profess that this, which I am about to receive, is truly your most precious Body and Blood, which, I pray, will make me worthy to receive for the remission of all my sins and life everlasting. Amen."

I would also like to take a moment to express my sincere prayers and blessings to all of our fathers, grandfathers and great grandfathers, both living and deceased. May you all continue to strive to follow the earthly example of St. Joseph in your important roles, as spouse, parent and Christian men living as disciples of Christ in our world today. May you also rely on the strength of the Heavenly Father, whom our Lord Jesus constantly reminded us in the One whose Will we must always strive to follow.

The Feast of Corpus Christithe Miracle of the Eucharist

In 1264, Pope Urban declared Corpus Christi a liturgical feast to be celebrated in the Catholic Church. Years earlier as a young priest in Liege, Belgium, the pope had heard of an Augustinian nun, St. Juliana of Cornillon who advocated for a feast day to celebrate Christ's real presence in the Eucharist.

Juliana was orphaned at an early age and raised in the convent. She showed great intelligence and was schooled in the teachings of the Church Fathers. She had a gift for contemplation and spent many hours in Eucharistic Adoration. Juliana was just 16 years old when Jesus began appearing to her during adoration. She understood that the Lord wanted Corpus Christi to be celebrated on a special day each year. This commemoration would increase the faith of believers, encourage them to adore "The Body and Blood" of Jesus and would make amends for offences against this Holy Sacrament. In 1246, Juliana and her spiritual companions were successful in encouraging the Bishop of Liege to introduce the solemnity of Corpus Christi and several other dioceses followed. It was not yet celebrated by the world-wide Catholic Church.

During this time there was growing debate among theologians as to the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. Such thoughts began troubling a young German priest, Father Peter of Prague. In 1263, the young priest, who was traveling to Rome, stopped in the town of Bolsena to offer Mass. During the mass when Father Peter recited the prayer of consecration, blood began seeping from the host onto the corporal and the altar.

At the time, Pope Urban was visiting the neighboring town of Orvieto. Informed of the miracle, he sent delegates to investigate and bring the evidence to the Cathedral in Orvieto where it re-

mains today. This Eucharistic Miracle confirmed the visions of St Juliana who had passed in 1858 in her humble cell while adoring the Blessed Sacrament. Six years after her death, Pope Urban celebrated the solemnity of Corpus Christi in Orvieto.

Since the days of the early Church, we have celebrated another special feast, Holy Thursday, the day on which Jesus gathered his Apostles and celebrated the First Eucharist and ordained his Apostles as the first priests. "Faithful to the Lords commands, the Church continues to do so in His memory until His glorious return, what he did on the eve of his Passion..." (from the Catechism of the Catholic Church)

As Catholics we have the priceless gift of the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, the food that feeds our souls. The communion prayer found in Father Bob's letter, can be said after receiving the sacrament and it reminds us of all the special graces offered.
