

### From the Pastor's Desk...



In 1970, John Paul Getty led the world's wealthiest family. The 2017 film *All the Money in the World* describes the kidnapping of one of his grandsons, for whom Mr. Getty will not pay the ransom. (FYI: I am not recommending this movie for I personally found it depressing, not entertaining). An incredulous reporter asked, "You won't pay the kidnappers? You have all the money in the world. What more could you possibly want?" With a sly smile, J. Paul Getty responded, "more money!" At first, this statement is shocking, but upon reflection we can almost recognize ourselves in his response. We want more of everything: money, security, health, etc. Qoheleth, Paul, and Jesus will challenge

Getty's quote and constant human craving for more.

According to Western culture, more is better. More money in our bank accounts, more power, more control, more health insurance, more security. The list is endless. At first, we might say, "Let's save for a rainy day," but we soon focus on where to place our energies. Today's readings move our listeners away from vain pursuits to a relationship with God that last forever. Money, possessions, control, and security won't last beyond this world. A relationship with God is eternal.

Like Qoheleth and Paul, Jesus warns his followers not to place their ultimate trust in material things instead of God. Jesus is not a worldly judge or arbitrator. His concerns are elsewhere, and ours should be too.

In the Mass, we celebrate God's greatest gift in our sharing in the Eucharist. Our sharing in the saving passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus is a preparation for sharing in God's eternal banquet in heaven. What do we all most need more of? We need more of Jesus and his saving love, mercy and forgiveness. Yes, I do believe that is the One Thing that we all need more of.




