In our readings this weekend, the Lord gives us a beautiful invitation.

The Lord speaks to us saying, "Ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives; and the one who seeks, finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened." - Luke 11:9-11

This passage speaks into the truth that many of us are seeking more in our lives, whether spiritually, emotionally, or physically. We desire deeper relationships with the Lord, spouses, families, and friends. We desire deeper, more intentional friendships with like-minded people. We desire better emotional and physical health, strength of body and mind. These are all good, holy desires, desires that the Lord wants us to invite Him into.

In this weekend's readings, the Lord is asking us to take these desires and bring them to His feet. He is asking us to allow Him to enter into these desires with us. After all, He desires what is truly best for us. This kind of "working together" can only bring the greatest good. A 2018 study states that "only around half of Americans (53 percent) have meaningful social interactions, such as having a conversation with a friend or spending quality time with family, on a daily basis". And while this is a worldwide problem, the Catholic church is uniquely equipped to combat this each week.

As faithful Catholics, we gather together each week in a seamless act of community. Through the Mass and other ministries we participate in, we are uplifted by other believers. We are surrounded by like minded individuals that are also looking to follow the Lord in their daily lives. We are connected by our desire to reach Heaven and to bring others with us.

At St. Pat's, we share all of these goals. We long for St. Pat's to be a place of unending community and sacramental grace. Thank you for seeking out intentional community here. Thank you for placing your desires into the hands of the Lord and asking Him to guide you. Thank you for being a part of the St. Pat's community!


