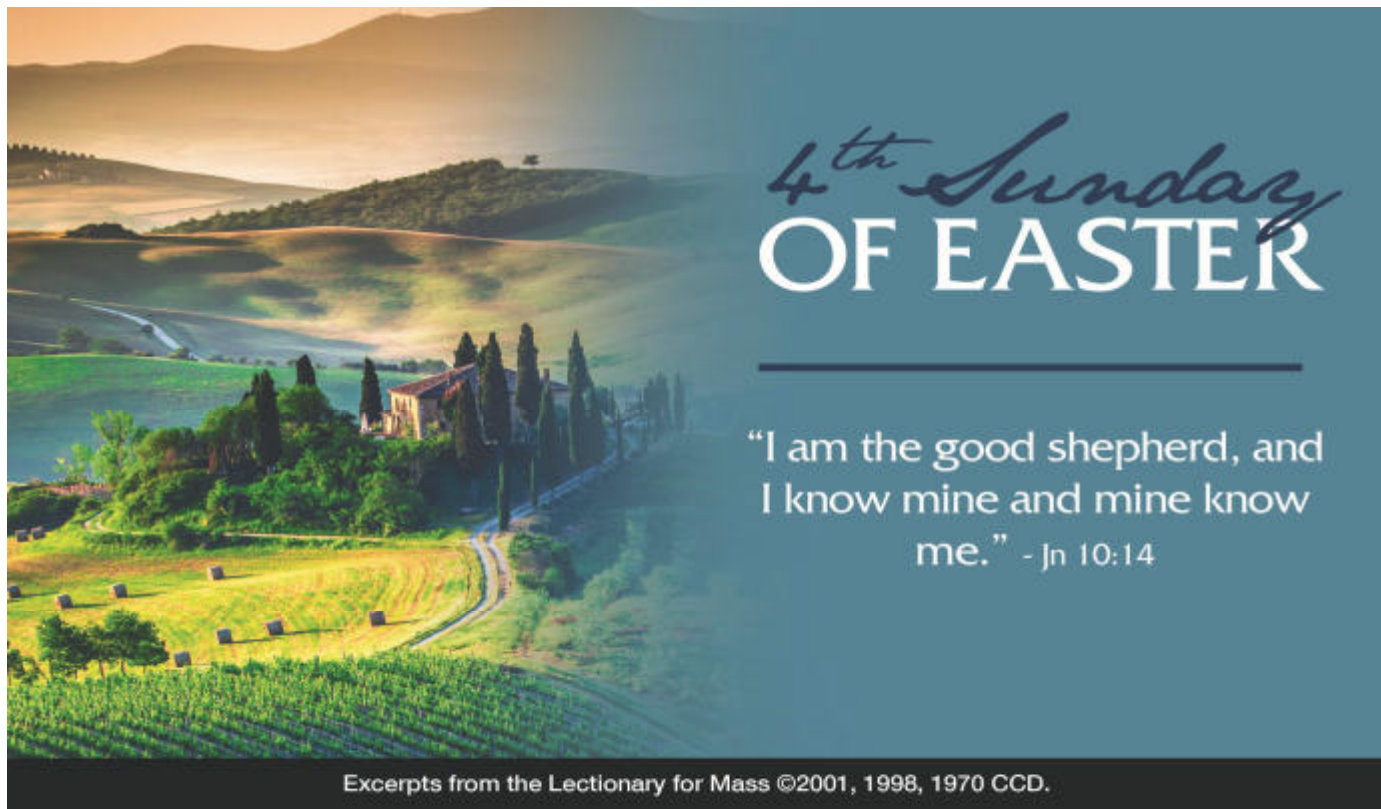

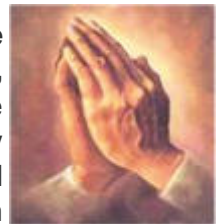

WATCH OUT FOR THE GATE

For several years, the New Cut Road entrance/exit at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church has posed significant safety concerns. These problems have become acute in recent weeks. Therefore, **the entrance at New Cut Road will be closed**; a gate has been installed and will be always locked, other than for drop-off and pick-up for St. Nicholas Academy, as well as during weekend Masses only. Please do not attempt to turn left any longer when exiting the New Cut Road entrance; this is a safety hazard – there have already been several auto accidents!

In effect the campus now has one, two-way lane via Southside Drive for entrance and exit. Please use an abundance of caution and drive slowly when traveling through the campus. There are people walking across and through our parking lot behind the church and school; this is particularly true for our school children and staff. Those needing access to the campus for morning Mass, business at the parish office or school office may still use the Southside Drive entrance, drive along the building to park and go in and out of the buildings.

This is being done to keep people wishing to turn right onto Southside and avoid the traffic light, from cutting through the campus when traveling north on New Cut Road.

Additionally, it provides extra needed security and safety. It is a year-round change in the traffic pattern. I do apologize for any inconvenience this creates for you, but the safety of our children and parishioners is my primary concern at the present time.

LOST PYXES

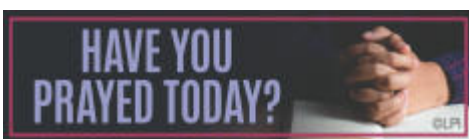

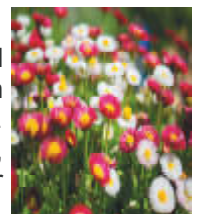
ST. VINCENT dePAUL CLIENTS

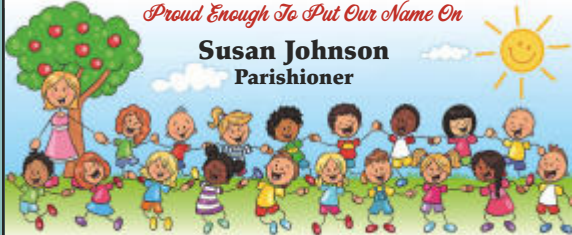
