

It seems worthwhile to follow up on the pandemic-related developments of last week, and to offer a few clarifications.

Some time ago, Archbishop Rozanski issued instructions that everyone was required to wear masks when entering church and during the entirety of Holy Mass. When the CDC advised that masks were not required for the fully vaccinated, that requirement was adjusted. Now masks are not required in church, **for those who are vaccinated**. Of course anyone who prefers to continue to wear a mask is welcome to do so.

Aside from that change, the directives we are asked to follow have not changed very much. I think I have referred to this resource before, but I again direct everyone's attention to archstl.org/coronavirus. This is where the diocesan leadership makes public the measures to be taken by parishes. As of this writing, the most recent update at that site is from May 17, and you will find that it leaves in place many of the restrictions we have been observing for close to a year now. I hope everyone will continue to be patient.

At the same time, all the schools in the diocese were instructed to continue the mitigation strategies they have had in place all year, including during end-of-year activities. By the time this bulletin goes out, we will have just one more week of school to get through!

In happier news, our Senior Club was able to meet for the first time in over a year, and had their summer picnic with fried chicken, beans, and potato salad. It was good to see the parish hall full of people again (but not so full that I was worried), and to see friends talking to each other who hadn't been able to for a long time. Fr. Tom also came by and had lunch with us. It was truly a joyful occasion.

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has issued an update after reviewing guidance on mask wearing from the CDC and local government health departments. **If you are not yet fully vaccinated against COVID-19, please continue to wear a mask while in church.** Masks are no longer required for people who are fully vaccinated. If you are vaccinated and are more comfortable wearing a mask, you are certainly welcome to continue that practice.



Archbishop Mitchell Rozanski leaves in place the dispensation for Sunday Mass at this time, but will be re-evaluating the need for the dispensation in the coming weeks.

As noted in the Archdiocese's announcement, our school will continue the mitigation strategies they have had in place that have led to a successful full year of in-person learning.

Father Nickolai will be reviewing all the information he is receiving from the Archdiocese with parish staff in the coming days, and any further changes will be announced.






Gloria
