You may notice at your seats today new books (alongside the “Gather” books we already had). A word of explanation: once we were allowed by diocesan guidelines to have pew books again, I first assumed we’d simply order more of the kind we were already using. But, it turned out that our usual supplier was out of books for the current season, and wouldn’t be making any more until the new liturgical year.

I didn’t really want to wait until November for books, so after looking at a couple of options I decided to try this new one, the St. Augustine Hymnal. One feature I found attractive is the inclusion of a complete three-year lectionary cycle. For those who may not know already, our Sunday readings are arranged according to a pattern that repeats every three years: Year A uses mostly the Gospel of St. Matthew, Year B (which we’re currently in) uses St. Mark — supplemented with St. John, since Mark’s Gospel is the shortest, and Year C uses Gospel readings taken mostly from St. Luke.

One advantage, therefore, of the new hymnal is that we will not need to change the books every few months — and we will be throwing away books less frequently. We will also save a little money this way, especially if the books hold up for at least a few years, and if they are handled gently enough.

Finally, now that we can have “permanent” books in the church, this marks the end of the policy we had been going by since May of 2020. I was glad to let people take missalettes home with them, and bring a “personal” copy back and forth to church, when we were concerned about the transmission of disease by sharing these materials. But the new books are to remain in the church. To avoid confusion on this point, all the books have been stamped with the parish name on the inside cover.



### Weekly Stewardship Reflection

"He said to them, "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while." MARK 6:31

Do you spend time, every day, alone and in silence listening to how God is calling you? If not, you are missing out on a wonderful opportunity to develop a more personal relationship with Him. Unless we talk and more importantly, listen to God every day, how else will we know how He is calling us? Consider making a retreat this year, spend some "alone" time with God.

**Water... It's What's Good For You!**

Of all the food and beverage choices we face on a daily basis, what is calorie free basically cost free and essentially keeps us alive? However, those are not the only reasons to drink water. Water drives our basic body performance. Here are 5 reasons to drink water:

- **It will help you de-stress.** Drinking water during a particularly stress filled day will help soothe stress induced symptoms. Staying hydrated will eliminate headaches, tense muscles, fuzzy thinking, a pounding heart and low energy.
- **You will lose weight.** Just drinking water will not help you lose weight. The key is to drink 2 – 8 ounce glasses of water before each meal. This will give you the feeling of being full before you eat and then you will not eat as much. The other benefit is that your body will work more efficiently when it is hydrated.
- **You will be less apt to get sick.** Hydration keeps our mucus membranes in top order. They are the “gatekeepers” to the natural defense system that helps keep out germs such as cold and flu viruses. When the mucus membranes are dry, germs can penetrate more easily.
- **You will be more comfortable.** It doesn't matter the temperature of the water, it will keep you cool on a hot day and warm on a cold day. Our body's temperature-regulating system likes it when we are well hydrated.
- **It will help you regulate your blood pressure.** In 2010, the American Red Cross discovered that blood donors that drank 16 ounces of water prior to donating were less likely to faint when giving blood. Fainting is basically caused by a sudden drop in blood pressure so staying hydrated may keep your blood pressure from dropping.

**Water is your friend! It is natural, calorie free, preservative free (more or less), inexpensive and always available. So..... DRINK UP!!!**

A group of parishioners from St. Rose Philippine Duchesne Parish help feed the hungry by providing casseroles and desserts to the Rosati House on Grand Avenue. Rosati house consists of transitional living apartments for homeless mentally ill individuals who are trying to change their lives. The Rosati House is staffed 24 hours a day by a manager, social workers, aides and cooks. Residents are assisted with making applications for housing and benefits, taught grooming and hygiene, and are helped with employment counseling as well as many other things. **UNDERSTANDING MEDICARE**


Are you approaching age 65? Are you working past age 65 and are considering retirement? Are you currently enrolled in Medicare and would like to know that you're in the right plan?

**GOSPEL MEDITATION**  
 Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

There's an ordinary pine grove located on a tree farm not too far from town where life's stresses and demands seem to melt away. It is here that all that seemed so important out there no longer is and one can get lost in the rows of trees and majestic beauty. God is here and all is good. We need to connect with the Divine Source of all that is in order to understand what it is we are doing and why we are doing it. Otherwise, things stop making sense and bitterness can overcome one's spirit. It's okay to play once in a while and to discover that place of profound life and peace. People always have needs and there is constantly something to do. And while all of that is necessary and we are needed, there is also that inner solitude within that needs to be celebrated and released.

We all need a pine grove. It's that little place we can go and leave all that consumes us behind. It's a place where technology can be set aside and wonder, and awe given some time. We don't have to text, calculate, or orchestrate anything in the pine grove. It is a somewhat deserted place where all of that can be set aside and we can just be. The anger, frustration, exhaustion, discouragement, helplessness, and occasional apathy, all can fall to the ground like all of those pine needles that once held their place on the branch of a Frasier Fir. The needles can let go. We can let go. We are beings connected with Being and we all need to remember what really matters, who really matters and what life is truly all about. We need to find that place where we can rest and let go of all of the barnacles we accumulate. Rest, breathe, seek, and love.

The world will need us again when we leave the pine grove. It will all be waiting for us, beckoning for our attention. But we will have prayed and will have marveled at the silence and the beauty of goodness. We can go back, ready, and eager to listen, to help, to heal, to cry, to embrace, and attend to all that is asked of us. But, having let go of the distractions in that deserted place we will have a renewed sense of purpose. We will know better Who it is we serve and what we are meant to do. It will all be clearer now that we have been Divinely touched and refreshed.


### Gloria
