August 8 is the feast day of Saint Dominic, although this year the Sunday in Ordinary Time takes precedence.

Traveling through Europe in the year 1203, Dominic first recognized the need for an order devoted to preaching, in order to combat heresy. The idea came to him when he saw firsthand the wreckage caused by the heretical movement called the “Albigensians.”

The Albigenses believed the cosmos was ruled by two opposing forces, one good and one evil. (This perhaps sounds much like the premise of a certain series of science-fiction films.) Further, the evil force produced all matter — including human bodies — while the good force created only spiritual things. A number of consequences followed from these principles. For one, marriage was evil, because it tended to produce new life, which to the Albigensians meant trapping souls in a prison of wicked flesh. This meant in turn rejecting the Incarnation, for then the Son of God himself would have been subverted by the evil force. Thus, the death of Christ was illusory — if he never took on human nature, he never suffered death either. The Albigenses also held that the Old Testament was the work of the evil force, while the New Testament was the work of the good force. This idea still has some currency in our time, which just shows there are no new heresies.

What the Albigenses had in their favor, and helped them gain a foothold, was their rigorous ascetical discipline. Again, this flowed from their principles — if the body is evil, doing anything to sustain it is also evil. In fact, the Albigensian ideal was to die of starvation. On the other hand, the Catholic clergy were often a scandal, living lax and self-indulgent lives. Dominic saw the need for learning, for better theological training, but he also saw the need for the kind of fasting and mortification that makes prayer and preaching effective. He was able to convince clergy and religious to reform their lives accordingly, and so is credited with thousands of conversions to the true Faith. St. Dominic, pray for us!

Four Steps to Food Safety at Home

1) Clean:

Wash your hands and surfaces often. Germs that cause food poisoning can survive in many places and spread around the kitchen. Wash hands for 20 seconds with soap and water before, during, and after preparation of food and before serving. Wash your utensils, cutting board, and countertops with hot soapy water. Rinse fresh fruits and vegetables under running water.

2) Separate:

Don't cross contaminate. Raw meat, poultry, seafood and eggs can spread germs to ready-to-eat foods unless they are kept separate. When shopping, keep raw meats, poultry and seafood and their 'juices' away from other foods. Keep raw meats, poultry, seafood, and eggs separate from other foods in the refrigerator.

3) Cook:

Cook food at the right temperature. Food is safely cooked when the internal temperature gets high enough to kill germs that can make you sick. The only way to know for sure is to use a food thermometer.

4) Chill:

Refrigerate promptly in a refrigerator that is 40 degrees or below. Know when to throw food out. Refrigerate within 2 hours unless outdoor temperature is over 90 degrees, then within 1 hour. Thaw frozen food in the refrigerator, cold water, or the microwave. Never thaw food on the counter because bacteria multiply quickly in the parts of food that reach room temperature.
