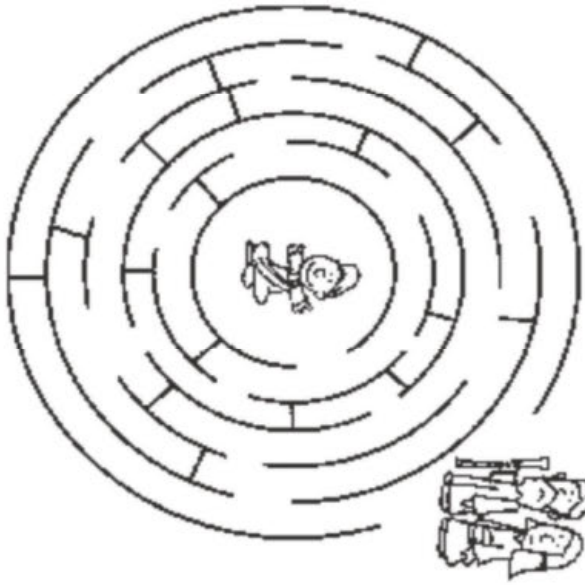

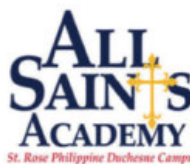
A Christmas Blessing

Penitential Act (Confiteor)
