

# Important COVID-19 update

As news about COVID-19 continues to spread as quickly as the virus itself, it's difficult to know which information is important for you and your family. Here is an update from **SSM Health**.

#### Testing—what you should know:

If you need a COVID-19 test, and are not experiencing symptoms, please do not visit the emergency room. Visit the Missouri Department of Health's website for a list of asymptomatic testing locations in our community.

If you are experiencing mild symptoms and want to seek medical attention, please schedule an appointment with your primary care provider or complete a virtual visit.

Due to unusually high volumes, testing at our Urgent Care and Express Clinics is limited to those with COVID-19 symptoms. We cannot perform testing for travel, events, exposures, or return to work.

#### News from our facilities:

Because our nurses, staff, and facilities are stretched to the limit during this latest COVID-19 surge, we have made the difficult decision to begin postponing some non-urgent procedures and surgeries. Your physician's office will be in touch with you if your procedure is affected.

Hospital inpatients at all of our locations are limited to one designated visitor per day, with the exception of pediatrics and our Family Birthplaces

#### If you're not yet vaccinated, it's not too late.

- The vaccine remains the best way we can combat this virus and keep yourself and your loved ones safe, well and out of the hospital.
- Vaccines are available for those age 5 and above, and boosters are available to those 12 and older.
- Third doses have also been approved for children ages 5-11 with compromised immune systems.
- Boosters can now be given <u>five</u> months after you complete your initial round of vaccines.

SSM Health is offering vaccination appointments across the St. Louis region.

We can pull through this together.

- You can help by getting vaccinated and continuing to practice safety measures, such as wearing a mask in public, maintaining physical distancing, washing your hands often, and avoiding large crowds.
- SSM Health is committed to providing the best possible care to <u>all</u> our patients throughout the pandemic.


## ST. ROSE SENIOR CLUB MEETING

DPH's three permanent health centers located in Berkeley, Pine Lawn, and Sunset Hills, are also testing by appointment only this week. 




