

Common Cold or Covid-19 Coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms

COVID-19 affects different people in different ways. Most infected people will develop mild to moderate illness and recover without hospitalization. The CDC does not list different symptoms for the Delta variant or others.

Most common symptoms include:

Fever

Dry cough

Tiredness

Less common symptoms:

Aches and pains

Sore throat

Diarrhea

Conjunctivitis

Headache

Loss of taste or smell

a rash on skin, or discoloration of fingers or toes

Serious symptoms:

Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath

Chest pain or pressure

Loss of speech of movement

Seek immediate medical attention if you have serious symptoms. Always call before visiting your doctor or health facility.

On average it takes 5–6 days from when someone is infected with the virus for symptoms to show, however it can take up to 14 days.

Just a reminder if you or a family member go into the hospital and would like a visit from Father Nickolai, you or someone in your family must contact the parish. Under HIPAA guidelines, the hospitals can not contact your parish.


We have had more and more of our parishioners go into the hospital—again, the only way we know, is if a family member calls us.


World Marriage Day
