Last weekend, in reflecting on the second reading, the First Letter to the Corinthians, I had mentioned that the small group of Christians in Corinth were trying to understand what it meant to be Baptized followers of Christ. Isn't that what we should continually do in our changing world? In less than a month, we begin the great season of Lent. It is a time to return to our baptism. And our tradition has given us different tools for doing that. It is not too early to think of how this upcoming Lent might be different this year.

Each of the three readings this weekend, reflects on the experience of being commissioned as servants of God. As different as these three situations are—a Hebrew prophet in the Solomonic Temple, a Galilean fisherman surprised by an enormous catch, and a Greek-writing Pharisee reflecting on being a Christian convert—the three scenarios have startlingly similar elements. For Each of these men is confronted by an awe-some manifestation of divine power.

In each case, what followed a sense of unworthiness, was a divine assurance and—the biggest surprise of all—a commission. What jumped out at me was the line, heard again, so early, in Luke's Gospel: "Do not be afraid."

How often must we be reminded of that phrase, and take it in? Perhaps we need to hear that phrase now, as we look to a new reality with the Renew My Church process. Perhaps we need to silently listen for the place that God is calling us, assuring us, and commissioning us to a return to our Baptismal Call, and a new type of being Church.

Take this to your prayer, Sisters and Brothers. Listen. Listen to God's will in our current history. Do you wish to be part of something new? Do you wish to make way for a fresh Divine manifestation? Pope Francis said that God—if we trust in him—frees us from our sin and opens a new horizon before us: to cooperate in his mission. Could that be true?
