I am looking forward to a lot of exciting things going on in Muskego in 2021. There are a number of new businesses that are in the process of opening soon or starting construction, such as The Local Bar & Grill on Hillendale Road, Milk Can on Janesville Rd, and Dunkin Donuts/Baskin-Robbins on Racine Avenue. Pop's Market Place always has some fresh activities going on or grab a game of bowling at Alpine Lanes. New this year - outside heated domes at Crush, Muskego Lakes Country Club, and Bass Bay Brew House to allow for outside dining and beverages. Not a fan of the outdoors in winter? POLICE DEPARTMENT

HELLO MUSKEGO CITIZENS,

I hope this newsletter finds all of you able to get out and enjoy winter. Yes, I did say “enjoy” winter. As I write this, we have not had any measurable snow but as we all know, it will be here before we know it. I actually enjoy a winter that has plenty of snow. If you don’t like winter I will apologize now. Muskego has many outdoor winter activities to enjoy, such as sledding, ice fishing, and snowmobiling, just to name a few.

Please remember that winter parking regulations are in effect from Dec. 1st to April 1st.

Local ordinance prohibits parking any vehicle on any street or highway between the hours of 3 AM and 7 AM. This ordinance is in effect so that in the event of a snowfall, Muskego’s Department of Public Works (DPW) can plow the roads efficiently. If you need to park a vehicle on the road overnight, you can call the police department and we will grant you permission, as long as weather conditions allow.

When the snow does arrive, often we receive complaints from citizens about neighbors plowing snow onto their property or onto the road. We also have an ordinance prohibiting this. See below:

Snowplowing:

1. No person shall plow snow on his driveway or sidewalk or road in such a way as to interfere with his neighbor’s customary use and enjoyment of his property.

2.No person shall put snow by any means onto any public street, roadway, or thoroughfare. This subsection shall not apply to municipal snowplows.

We ask that you do not move the snow from your driveway into the road or onto your neighbor’s property. That either makes more work for DPW or it isn’t being very “neighborly”. Looking out for the good of your neighbor will go a long way toward building a positive relationship with them.

2020 was a challenging year for us at the police department, just as it was for everyone. Due to COVID-19 we had to change the way we policed this community while still providing the service you expect. Despite the uncertainty of 2020, we observed this city come together and unite to “weather the storm”. Watching this community come together to help struggling individuals and businesses, speaks volumes about the character of the people of Muskego. I also thank all of you

for your support of our officers during 2020. The outpouring of “thank yous” and gifts to our department has been amazing. You may not realize how much a simple “thank you” means to officers during difficult times.

We are always honored to serve the people of this great city and we look forward to 2021. Thank you for all you do to help make Muskego a great place to live and work. Until next time...

CITY DEVELOPMENT

Residential Development Stats for 2020

The year 2020 was a memorable year for everyone for many reasons. The City of Muskego Community Development Department remained busy throughout the year with new single-family home construction, remodels, additions, sheds, and exterior property improvements.

The Community Development Department issued the following permits in 2020:

- 49 permits for single family homes at a total value of more than \$21 million, averaging more than \$436,000 per new home, without the cost of the land.
- 483 Building Permits at a total value of more than \$10.5 million

(\$21,833.29 average per project) for residents investing in their existing homes and properties.

- 157 Zoning Permits for property improvements including fences, patios, driveways, retaining walls, and culverts.







- **Hillendale Drive Project** from Racine Avenue to College Avenue will be awarded in January 2021. The plan is for Construction to start in March/April 2021 with a Fall 2021 finishing date. The road will be closed to through traffic during construction. The City will work with Mill Valley School to provide a traffic plan for parents during the construction.
