

Adult Formation/Scripture Study

We will be starting a new Scripture Study program entitled "The Bible and The Sacraments". While Catholics know the sacraments are important, many never fully grasp how lifechanging these "masterworks of God" really are. They are incredible "powers that come forth' from the Body of Christ" (CCC 1116). This program can unveil the mystery of the sacraments and their foundation in Sacred Scripture. It is a twelve week video based study produced by the St Paul Center with Dr. Scott Hahn. The sessions will be offered on Monday evenings at 7:00 and the same session will be offered on Wednesday mornings at 10:30. Each session will last about one hour. There is a Study Guide that will cost \$20, which also allows you to view the program from your home if you wish. We plan on starting on Monday January 17th. All sessions will be held in the Education Bldg. There may not be a sign-up sheet in the church Gathering Space, so if you are interested, please email or call Deacon Bob or Kathy Hart at 502-722-5026 so that the study guides can be ordered and arrive on time.

V Encuentro—Ministry Series

This is a Formation via on-demand videos, workbooks, and community for 28 Ministerial Areas. It provides national professional development opportunities in English and Spanish that inspire, connect and offer opportunities to hear best practices, as well as present new initiatives and pastoral responses that emerged from the V Encuentro process. This program is designed for Leaders in parishes who would like to improve their service in the Hispanic/ Latino community. Also for Leaders from other ministries and ethnic group interested in a particular ministerial area. The cost per connection is \$28 and includes 28 sets of videos and workbooks, in English and Spanish. Connections are sold as diocesan, organizational and individual memberships. The Light of the Moon

If you own a television that has been turned on at any point in the last month or so, chances are you've caught at least a scene or two of the 1946 classic film "It's a Wonderful Life."

If you're not familiar with the movie, it follows the life of George Bailey from childhood through adulthood. A dreamer by nature, George has big plans for himself that involve world exploration and adventure — but family and community obligations keep him tethered to the same spot on the map, leading an altogether ordinary life.

One of the most memorable scenes from that movie is of George dancing with his sweetheart Mary while they sing "Buffalo Gals — Won't you come out tonight/And dance by the light of the moon?"

That lyric always catches my ear. Of course, the moon doesn't have any light of its own. All the moon has is the ability to reflect the light that shines upon it.

The same holds for us, doesn't it? Our stewardship is purely a reflection of the grace granted to us by another. "Upon you the LORD shines," writes Isaiah, "and over you appears his glory." Every good action we will ever take begins in the mind of God. The fact that we have the honor of carrying it out on His behalf is a beautiful gift. It is God that makes our ordinary lives extraordinary.

In the end of the movie, George Bailey realizes that he had a far greater life because, instead of being the hero of his own story, he allowed himself to reflect goodness onto others.





Saint of the Week

The patron saint of Catholic schools, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton (August 28, 1774 – January 4, 1821) was born in New York City to a prominent family of the Episcopal faith. When she turned 19, she married a wealthy businessman with whom she had five children. He later died of tuberculosis in 1803, leaving her a young widow. After discovering the Catholic faith in Italy, where her husband had died, she returned to New York and converted to Catholicism in 1805.

After several years struggling as a single mother, Elizabeth moved in 1809 to Emmitsburg, Maryland, where she founded the Sisters of Charity of St. Joseph, the first community for religious women established in the United States. She also began St. Joseph's Academy and Free School, which started a chain reaction of Catholic-based education in the United States that continues today.

St. Elizabeth Ann Seton was canonized September 14, 1975 in St. Peter's Square by Pope Paul VI and was the first citizen born in the United States to be given the title of "saint."
