


Sacramento del Bautismo

Our first Fish Fry meeting was held on Monday, January 3rd. Here are the minutes of the meeting:



Fish Fry 2022 Meeting: January 3, 2022

- 1. Chair: Mr. Larry (Chief) Montalto, has volunteered to be our Chair and Mr. Kent Herold as Co-Chair.
- 2. Orders: Ms. Kathy Reed has volunteered as Chair and Ms. Theresa Rogers as Co-Chair.
- 3. Location to Fry the Fish: Temporary, Mr. Jim Eberle will talk to neighbor to rent a building temporarily to place the fryers.
- 4. Source(s) for Fish and Preparation Preparation by Parishioners. It was decided that all fish will be prepared in house.
- Dates and Times Dates: March 4, 11, 18, 25; April 1, and 8. No Fish Fry on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Times: Lunch 11:00 am to 1:00 pm; and Dinner from 4:30 pm to 7:00 pm.
- Menu and Prices: Fish Sandwich \$7 (white, wheat, dary rye, white rye bread) Sides—All sides are \$2 each: Mac & Cheese, Fries, Hush Puppies, Cole Slaw, Desserts. We will ask parishioners to donate desserts. Other items and drinks: Ceviche \$5, Cheese Pizza \$2, Beer Domestic \$3, Beer Imported \$4, Soda/Water/Tea/Lemonade \$2.
- 7. Recruitment of Volunteers: All of our parishioners that are registered as members. For: Preparation of fish, Cooks, Servers, Dishwashers, Table Cleaning, and Trash, Cashiers (all our cashiers will receive training).
- 8. Parish Hall Setting: A layout of the traffic flow will be presented in the next meeting. This will explain the placement of the cashiers, serving area, telephone orders, tables, desserts, drinks, and carry out orders.
- 9. Advertising: To publish in Diocesan and local papers, and Shelby Life magazine.

- 10. Cordless phone or Installation of land line at Parish Hall. This will be use for carry out orders. Emilia will look into it.
- 11. Other items:
 - → Kitchen needs trays for warmers—Kathy
 - → Volunteers need gloves and head covers
 - ➔ 3 coolers are needed—Fr. David
 - → 4 bags of ice are needed; ice maker is too small
