As Catholics, we are called to serve those in need but many times, because of our routines or social circles, we are unable to see or meet them in our daily travels and schedules. Recently, our parish received a request to support the International Institute of St. Louis. This organization assists with physical needs, such as groceries and educational support, of immigrants new to our area. Currently, they are helping some 1500 refugees relocate from Afghanistan to St. Louis. The International Institute of St. Louis is in critical need of grocery cards to Schnucks grocery markets, where the majority of newly arrived Afghans are shopping due to accessibility. These gift cards are given directly to Afghan families so that they can purchase the items they need for their families. You can purchase Schnucks gift cards yourself in amounts of \$25, \$50 or \$100 or you can make a donation to a special collection on the weekend of January 22-23 and IW will use the funds raised to purchase gift cards to be distributed. We appreciate your generosity as we work to serve all those in our midst!

Lastly, please be considerate of others in this time of widespread illness from both Omicron and the flu. We want to work together to stay healthy. If you are not feeling well, even if you test negative for Covid, please remember that you may still be contagious with other illnesses. Use common sense and courtesy and remember that those who are ill are not required to attend Mass. We are happy that so many have returned to weekly worship and do not want to discourage anyone from coming to Mass. Please continue to be mindful of your health and considerate of others.

In August of 2020, thanks in total to the generosity of many of our school families and parish friends, Incarnate Word Parish School was able to set up a nursery for our teachers with young children. The concept of an onsite nursery was to help retain those members of Incarnate Word's outstanding teaching staff who might otherwise be faced with leaving Catholic Education for higher paying employment as they start their young families and require daycare. As you may remember, the nursery is not funded by the parish or school. What you may not realize is that since the nursery is not funded by any source, the teachers pay monthly tuition to cover the cost of the nursery staff. We have donors who have inquired and are making nursery tuition contributions and thought there might be others who would be interested in doing so.

We currently have 5 staff with 7 babies utilizing the nursery.

One of the key components of a great school is having great teachers. During these years of the global pandemic, many of you have been able to witness virtually first hand, the devotion, dedication and perseverance of this fine staff determined to bring our students the very best they could during these extraordinary times while many schools, near and far, were not able to create the same successes for their students. Henry Brooks Adam said "Teachers affect eternity; no one can tell where their influence stops."




