

This past Friday, hundreds of thousands of people gathered in our Nation's capitol to mark the sad anniversary of the Roe vs Wade Supreme Court decision which legalized abortion in

1973. During these 49 years, it estimated that at least 62 million innocent babies have been killed and countless men and women have been profoundly wounded by the decision to allow, and in some cases promote, this evil act. Life is a fundamental right upon which all other rights build upon and every human person is entitled to live, regardless of the circumstances in which they were conceived or the environment where they will be born. Please continue to pray for an end to the scourge of abortion. Pray for the men and women who have chosen abortion out of fear and despair and now carry the shame, regret, and self-hatred of their decision. Pray for a conversion of heart for the doctors, nurses, and all other advocates of abortion. Hope, mercy, and love are the only things that will defeat the forces of evil. We should never become accustomed to abortion or apathetic because it has been allowed so long. Constant prayer will show us what each of us of us are called to do so all may have the right to life and live it abundantly!

This weekend, members of the Women's ACTS Retreat team will be speaking before all the Masses. The next retreat will take place February 17-20 at Marianist Retreat Center and we invite all women of our parish to consider taking these several days to have their spirits renewed by grace and grow in their relationship with God. Many wonderful transformations have taken place during these retreats and profound friendships formed!

Next Saturday, *That Man is You (TMIY)* will restart for another semester. This program combines Scripture, research, small group discussion, and humor to address the pressures and temptations facing men in our modern culture. It seeks to form authentic and well-balanced leaders who will be capable of transforming homes and society. It gives practical tips on how to help the men of our parish be the best husbands, fathers, grandfathers, and professionals possible. This is open to all men, 18 and older, and runs from 6:30-8am on Saturdays in the Lower Church Hall and includes breakfast. The reason for this early start time is to enable dads with kids to attend without taking them away from their responsibilities to their families. Did you know this about the Knights of Columbus?

"Life is a gift from God. Each human person is created by God out of love and in his own image, endowed with an immortal soul. Because of this, each person has an inherent dignity, and each life is sacred.

We recognize these truths in principle, and yet so much of our culture does not. Abortion, assisted suicide and euthanasia devalue lives that are deemed inconvenient, unwanted or burdensome."

"This culture of death requires and demands of us a spiritual response,' said Sister Maris Stella of the Sisters of Life. It requires and needs men who will stand up for life, men who will stand up for the weak, the poor, the vulnerable, the elderly, the handicapped — and that begins within their own families."

"We are called to protect: Protecting those who are vulnerable is one of man's most basic responsibilities — which is why it is tragic when a man fails to step up and defend the most vulnerable humans of all —unborn children — especially when it is his own child's life at stake."

"Sister Maris Stella, who is a former officer in the U.S. Navy, recalled being in a group praying outside an abortion clinic when a middle-aged man drove up and rolled down his window. He thanked her for being there as a witness and recalled how, 27 years earlier, he had driven his girlfriend to a clinic for an abortion but was dissuaded when he saw men and women praying at the entrance. That day was his daughter's 27th birthday, and he was grateful that he had chosen life."

"If [the man] were to just say, 'Listen, I'll be with you. We can do this. I'll help you. I will be with this child regardless of what happens to us, I can tell you that probably about 9 out of 10 women would give birth to that child if they perceive that kind of support from the man,' said Mother Agnes Mary Donovan, superior general of the Sisters of Life."

"Sister Maris Stella and Mother Agnes were among experts interviewed for the "Life" episode of the Knights of Columbus' In to the Breach video series. The series and its accompanying study guide are inspired by the 2015 apostolic exhortation of the same name by Bishop Thomas J. Olmsted of Phoenix, which calls upon Catholic men to live out their faith and vocation more fully so as to help revitalize families, communities and the Church."

"Men Need Apply: As a young man, John Morales learned that his girlfriend was pregnant. Although he 'knew deep down in my heart' it was wrong, he wrote the check for an abortion — and he mourns that decision to this day."

"I realize that I will never see that child until I get to the other side of the veil,' said Morales, a host and managing editor at Relevant Radio. 'It left a hole in my heart. ... I went through bouts of depression. It was a decision that I'll regret for the rest of my life.' Men, Morales said, 'need to step up to the plate, and we need to do our part' in the pro-life battle against abortion".

"Sister Maris Stella added that men's presence and voice is greatly needed to encourage women to choose life, even on the frontlines as sidewalk counselors. 'The desire of a woman's heart is to choose life. It's simply imprinted the way that God created us,' she said. 'And men have a huge role in this. We [women] can tell a woman all day long that we think she'd be a great mother. Then we'll bring in one of our men volunteers, and he'll tell her the same thing — and it changes everything."

"Thomas Wurtz, director of Varsity Catholic, and Dave DeNuzzo Sr., founder of the men's ministry TrueManhood, [both] agreed ... [and] encourages men to be present in large numbers at the annual March for Life and other pro-life rallies to show that 'we as men are stepping out..."
