

### FROM THE PASTOR



Our parish cookbook will likely get quite a workout this weekend helping many parishioners prepare for Thanksgiving! Yet while turkey stuffing and grandma's green bean casserole may be top of mind, I hope we pause to remember that the seminal reason we gather is to thank our

loving God, who continuously reaffirms his love for us individually and as a community.

Thursday, we will have a special Thanksgiving Mass at 9 a.m. at St. Luke Church. I hope many of us will begin this busy day by celebrating together as a community around the Lord's table. This is a good way to enjoy the day, and to prepare for the season of Advent that begins a few days later.

Anticipating Advent, the scriptures this weekend complete the end time readings we have been hearing for the past several weeks. St. Paul in 1 Thessalonians warns us to "stay alert." Yet he reminds that "all of you are children of the light and children of the day. We are not of the night or of darkness." He tells us that Jesus, through his death and resurrection, has already enabled our redemption so long as we retain the light of His word.

We will encounter the imagery of light throughout Advent. Yet it's appearance in this week's scripture readings is a wonderful mark of the faith we carry and share together within our parish and with others we meet. We know that the light of our faith is a blessing we receive from God, and as we thank Him, we pray that we will have the strength to carry His light in everything we do, in every relationship we build, and in every challenge we face.

We also carry the light when we care for others. A special thanks to everyone who has contributed to the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) this weekend.

In other parish matters, Pilot Alpha has just completed its 10th week and will end on November 20. The leadership team that has been working to bring Alpha to this parish will then turn its attention to the Alpha that begins next year. The team is pictured on page 8, and I want to extend a special thanks for all their remarkable work.

Michelle Dal Pino, the Director of Lifelong Faith Formation, is no longer working for our parish. However, all Religious Education classes, RCIC and RCIA will continue as scheduled and without interruption. Once I have details on who will lead our Religious Education program for the balance of the school year, I will share that information with all of you.

### **Turkey Sunday Weekend is Here**

Three hundred twenty five frozen turkeys have been ordered from the River Forest Jewel and tons of other food have been ordered from Caputo's. As of the publication date, canned goods, fresh produce, stuffing and more will have been picked up from local grocery stores and delivered to the River Forest Community Center, (RFCC) where they are bagged. About one fifth of the turkeys were distributed at our St Vincent de Paul Food Pantry Saturday morning. The rest will be picked up for distribution at our three sites serving the North Lawndale, Austin and Little Village neighborhoods of Chicago, along with the 30 or so large frozen turkeys we hope to receive from parishioners.

This Sunday morning other volunteers will have loaded the bags of food onto large vehicles at the RFCC to be delivered to the distribution sites. 350 families will receive food for their Thanksgiving meals because of your generosity and volunteering to help. The families being served are both local at the St Vincent de Paul Food Pantry on Saturday morning or associated with our sharing parish, St Symon of Cyrene, on Sunday afternoon.

You can still help by donating a large frozen turkey, 20 lbs. or more, before and after any Mass **this Sunday up to 12:15 p.m.** 30 large frozen turkeys are needed for the large families getting Thanksgiving meals.

You can contribute to Turkey Sunday by giving cash or writing a check to St Luke and St Bernardine Parish and writing "SLSB Turkey Sunday" on the memo line and giving the contribution to a volunteer before or after every Mass this weekend. ### SVDP Pantry Marks Two Years of Change, Calls for Community Assistance

The St. Vincent de Paul Society (SVDP), St. Bernardine Conference, has been running the dry goods food pantry for many years, but is coming up to a two year anniversary since implementing changes to provide a grocery list for clients to fill out and wait while the order is filled. The clients are satisfied to receive what they select. Before, grocery bags were filled with staple items and given to the clients. Many items were returned as being not needed.

Our clientele has doubled over the last year, now serving 40-50 people per week. We count on the generosity of parishioners and benefactors to donate money or goods from the shopping list to stock the pantry. However, this has not been sustainable. The need has increased substantially and SVDP has been subsidizing a sizable amount of money each week to buy items to stock the pantry.

We appreciate you taking a pantry grocery list while you are shopping. The pantry needs items from the list and cannot accept outdated, open or used items.

A case of an item is also acceptable. Donations can be dropped off at the baskets located at the main entrance at St. Luke and by the south side entrance at St. Bernardine or on Saturday morning. To donate monetarily, please make a check out to the St. Vincent De Paul Society, St. Bernardine Conference and put in the Sunday collection basket or bring/send to the parish office. Any donations of clothing can be given to the SVDP drop off box at the St. Mary of Celle parking lot in Berwyn.

Starting December 1, 2023, SVDP's plan is to limit service to clients living in Forest Park, River Forest, Oak Park and Berwyn.

The pantry is open Saturdays from 9-11 a.m. at the St. Bernardine campus rectory, 7246 Harrison St., Forest Park. It stays open all year, unless inclement weather. Ellen Carr coordinates a designated number of volunteers to work on Saturday mornings and would call or text to confirm with the assigned individuals beforehand.

# Update from the Archbishop of Chicago Regarding the End of the Invest in Kids Act/Tax Credit Scholarship Program

Dear Friends in Christ,

The Illinois legislature abandoned nearly 10,000 children attending Catholic and other non-public schools this week by failing to renew the *Invest in Kids* scholarship program. Since 2017, *Invest in Kids* has empowered low-income families to choose the school that best meets their child's needs, providing them the same options more affluent families have.

For more than 175 years, Catholic schools in the Archdiocese of Chicago have provided students a high-quality, faith-based education that prepares them to lead, not just within our Church but in the broader, global community. Catholic schools have educated millions of Chicago area children of all faiths and none during that time.

During the past few years, thanks in large part to the Invest in Kids scholarship program and thousands of generous donors who contributed to the program, we were able to educate even more students who flourished academically. During the pandemic, because our schools made the bold choice to reopen safely, our students continued to grow academically. Many other schools were closed to in-person instruction and students in them, through no fault of their own, lost ground academically. How have Illinois' elected officials now responded to our students' academic success and to our schools' leadership and service during the pandemic? By pulling the rug from underneath thousands of needy families.

Unfortunately, Illinois' lawmakers ignored both the wishes of their constituents and their responsibilities to the struggling families of this state. Their failure now puts thousands of children at risk of losing the ability to stay in the school that best meets their needs.

This is a cruel and devastating outcome that will have far-reaching repercussions. Students will lose the scholarships that allowed them to attend our schools, those nearing graduation may not be able to graduate with classmates who have befriended them in these years, and families may no longer be able to choose the school that is best for their child.

I share my shock and disappointment at this situation with thousands of students, parents, educators, and other caring citizens throughout Illinois. However, our Catholic Schools, our other partner schools and the broader Catholic community will not be deterred by our elected officials' inaction and will continue to advocate on behalf of families in need. Over our 175 year history we have supported, to the best of our abilities, families in need who want to enroll their children in the school that best fits their needs. We will continue to walk with these families, regardless of their faith tradition, trusting in the support of our families and our generous donors. We take pride in the excellent Catholic schools in our archdiocese, and in our solid record of giving students, particularly those living in poverty, a chance to succeed in the future.

One of the most important decision parents make for their children is where they are going to send their children to school. Making that decision should not be denied to families in need. I ask all people of good will, particularly those who have been educated in our schools, to join me in the fight to provide the life-long advantage of a Catholic education to every family in need. Together we can make a difference.




