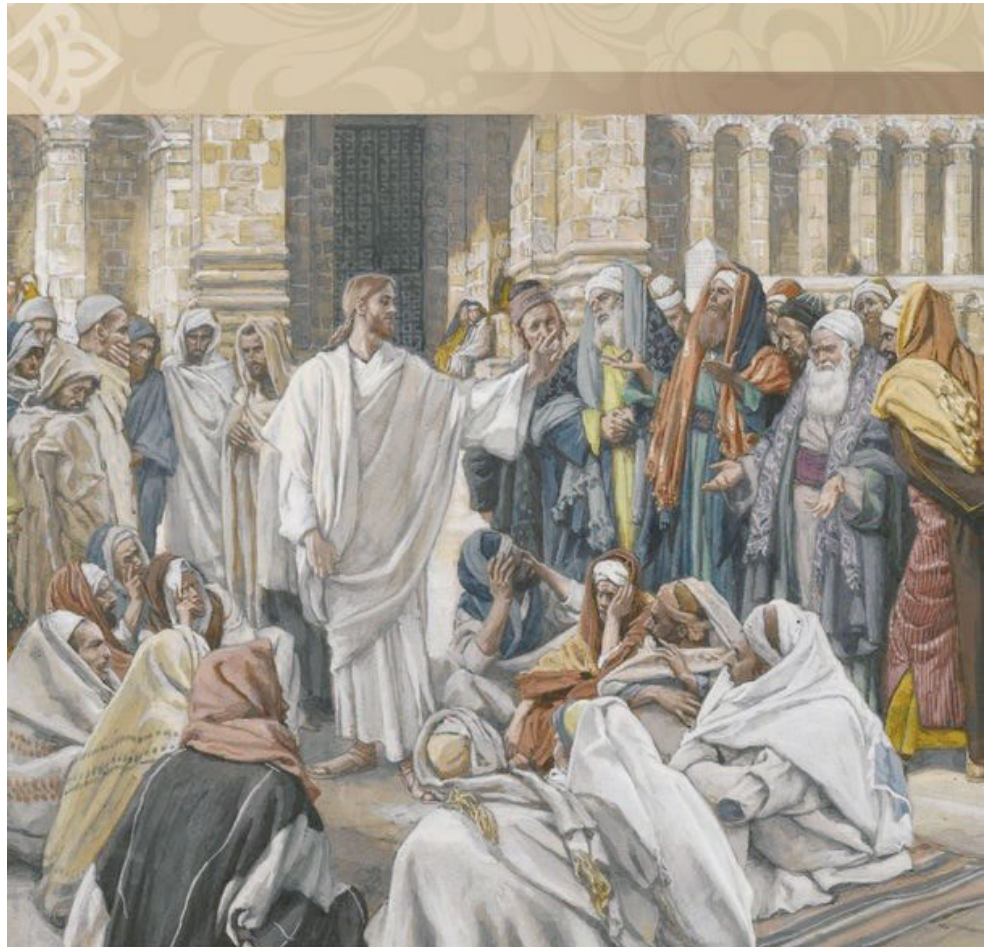

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

When we're confronted with criticism, what do we do? For example; "stop eating that, it's not good for your health" or "you really need to start an exercise program, your getting out of shape." But what about morality? In today's second reading St. Paul not only calls out the Colossians, but us too! *"Brothers and Sisters: if you were raised with Christ, seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Think of what is above, not of what is on earth. When Christ appears, then you too will appear with him in glory. Put to death, then, the parts of you that are earthly: immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and the greed that is idolatry. Stop lying to one another, since you have taken off the old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed, for knowledge, in the image of its creator."* Our normal response to any criticism is to dig our heels in and fight back. "No one's going to tell me what to do." Sound familiar? I know I've done it on many different levels. But the message Paul gives to each of us is that through our Holy Baptisms, we were dawned with a new life in Christ. Did our parents take it seriously? Were we truly brought up in the Catholic faith with good examples? Did we even have a foundation for what Paul is calling us to? For some, that answer is most definitely, and for others, not at all. But the gift of the Holy Spirit was imparted on each of us equally at our baptisms. Not half here and half there, but wholly. This means each of us has that gift within us, but it also means we need to work on using that gift. My friends, we are called to be better people, people that watch out for one another, people who help one another, people who see injustice and react. People who want to be HOLY! Like St. Paul says, when we start focusing on the things of heaven and not on earthly things, we begin to be the people God created us to be. Have a great week and know I am praying for you!
