

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Since an early age, I was always taught the obligation to go to Church every week. It was instilled in me by my mother as we attended Mass every Saturday evening. Sometimes there was a treat after, dinner at Burger King or Wranglers, or even Ponderosa on great occasions. So when I left home and went on to Eau Claire for school and later entered the Army, Church was something I always sought out. Sometimes it was a different Church each week. Sometimes it was because of the priest. But almost every Mass attended was the same, an obligation. One I wasn't willing to miss but also one that I just followed through the motions with. Upon leaving, if I was asked what I thought about the homily, I would reply it was really good. Then on the way home I would try and recall what was even said. During the creed I mouthed the words, but they never really sank in. In seminary we were asked to outline the format of the Mass. I have to say in all honesty that I did not know there were four parts of the Mass, The Preface (Introductory) Rite, The Liturgy of the Word (Old Testament, Responsorial, New Testament, and Gospel reading), Liturgy of the Eucharist, beginning with bringing forth of the gifts, and then the ending with the Concluding Rite (Closing prayer and dismissal with blessing). It was one of my first classes in seminary and it made me think "what the heck am I doing here, how am I going to learn all this!" This is one reason the priest is the last person to enter the sanctuary and the last person to leave the sanctuary. Mass is not complete until those two things happen. So when I left after communion all those years ago, I wasn't actually completing the full Mass, my mom and I missed an important part, the final blessing. After all those years, it took seminary for me to connect all the dots, that, not only am I attending Mass, but I am participating with an open heart in the whole Mass, start to finish. May we each see this gift not as an obligation as I did for years, but as the gift it is!




