FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

I've been very blessed to have close friends in my life spanning 40+ years. We've had our disagreements, our jabs at each other, and seen the other side of who we are. But I'm sure y'all have done the same thing (oops, all those years in Texas comes out every so often). The Opening Mass is set for October 12. This will again be a joint Mass with the sacrament for the Anointing of the Sick also happening.


