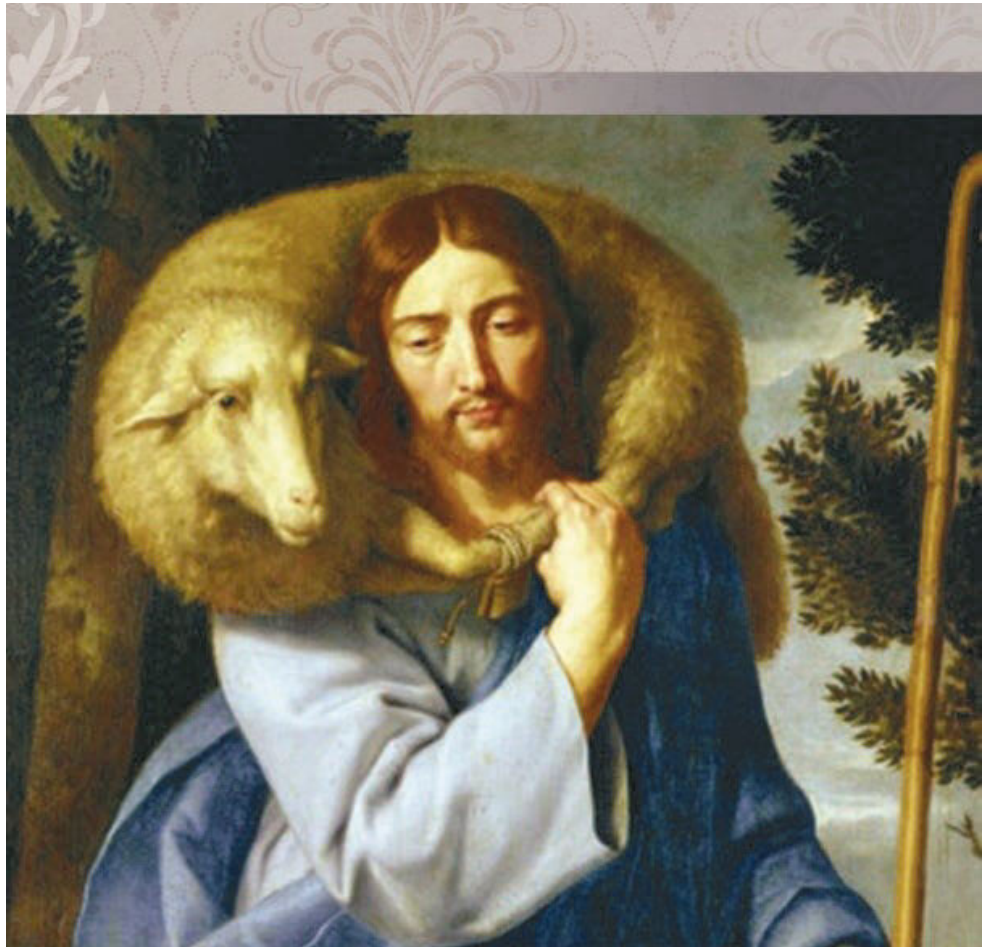

*FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK*

But I'm sure y'all have done the same thing (oops, all those years in Texas comes out every so often). There's never a shoulder to lean on, there's never confidence you can call them for something that might come up. There's never intent of nurturing the relationship. Thank you to everyone who came to Mass and entered into our drawing. We hope you had fun! The final drawings were pulled as families.

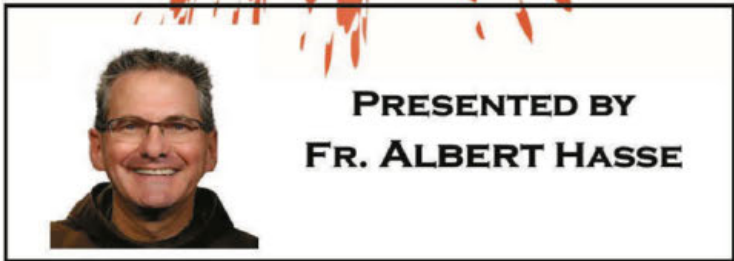
