

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

"The person who is trustworthy in very small matters is also trustworthy in great ones."

Says Jesus to his disciples in the Gospel passage from Luke. The parable he has just told them is a strange one, and so he attempts to flesh it out a little bit for them. And yet his follow-up to the parable is itself kind of puzzling, until he brings it to a close by saying some of the most famous lines in Scripture:

"No servant can serve two masters . . . You cannot serve both God and mammon."

In one sense, we can easily see this as cautioning us against choosing material treasure over spiritual treasure, choosing the things of this world over eternal things, choosing our own desires over God's. My friends, that's a battle that has been going on within every human heart since the dawn of time. But those aren't the only masters, the only opposite choices we face in life. There are others. The choice of being "all in" versus going only "part way", diving in versus dipping our toe in the water. This is the kind of commitment that lets us fool ourselves into believing, "Well, I'm not doing anything THAT bad, so God must be pretty pleased with me. I'm doing my part. I'm not the problem." And for most of us, this is a pretty easy list, a level of discipleship with the bar set very low. The one with all the small matters? The one that really doesn't look too bad on the surface? That's actually the one that says the most about who we are, deep down. That list is a more accurate measure of whether or not we are truly "buying into" all this Jesus stuff, whether or not we are "all in", whether or not our commitment involves everything we've got or just a part of us. And so, let's pledge to not just focus on the big stuff ... and thereby give ourselves a pass, give ourselves high marks in faithful living. Rather, let's stay focused on the small stuff too ... realizing and admitting that it is these things that truly show what kind of men and women we are.

Opening Mass is set for October 12. This will also be when the Anointing of the Sick sacrament is conferred. Please see the sign up sheet in the gathering room.


Raffle Items Needed
