WORDS FROM THE PASTOR 07

St. Augustine & Most Sacred Heart of Jesus Catholic Churches

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This week, we continue our dive into the Sanctus. The words “*Hosanna in the highest*” are a joyful cry of praise and salvation. In the liturgy of the Catholic Church, this line expresses both worship and hope. The word “*Hosanna*” comes from Hebrew and originally meant “save us, we pray.”

This phrase comes from the events recorded in the Bible when Jesus entered Jerusalem before His Passion. The people shouted “*Hosanna*” as they welcomed Him as the Messiah and Savior. Over time, the word became not only a plea for salvation but also a joyful shout of praise.

The phrase “*in the highest*” refers to heaven. It proclaims that this praise reaches to the highest place, to God Himself. It shows that this acclamation is not only earthly but heavenly.

At Mass, this line has special meaning because Christ is about to become present in the Eucharist. The faithful greet Him just as the crowds greeted Him in Jerusalem. They recognize Him as their Savior.

This line expresses joy, expectation, and faith. It reminds the faithful that salvation comes through Christ. It also shows that the Mass makes present the saving work of Jesus. By singing “*Hosanna in the highest*,” the faithful proclaim their belief that Jesus is truly present and that He comes to save His people.

May the Lord bless you and keep you! May the Lord let his face shine upon you and be gracious to you! May the Lord look upon you kindly and give you peace!
