This semester, our classroom has been filled with laughter, learning, faith, and plenty of muddy boots! Our classroom focused on learning through play, exploration, and hands-on experiences that helped our 2-year-old students grow socially, emotionally, spiritually, and academically in a loving Catholic environment.

One of the greatest blessings of this year has been watching the children build friendships and learn how to care for one another. Whether helping a friend put on rain boots, comforting a classmate, or taking turns during free play, the children practiced kindness and compassion every day. We worked hard to create a classroom where children felt safe, loved, and excited to come to school.

WORDS FROM THE PASTOR 07

St. Augustine & Most Sacred Heart of Jesus Catholic Churches

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

After the Holy, Holy, Holy is complete, we all kneel down recognizing what is about to happen, and I begin the Eucharistic Prayer. There are 10 Eucharistic Prayers officially approved for use in the Roman Missal and divided into the various categories, including the Four Primary Eucharistic Prayers (Numbered I-IV): These are the standard options. Eucharistic Prayer I also is known as the Roman Canon. I use this for major feast days. and it includes a list of the saints. You will hear Eucharistic Prayer II if you come to daily Mass because it is the shortest. Most Sundays I use Eucharistic Prayer III because it is not too short, not too long, but just right. Occasionally on Sundays during Ordinary Time, I will use Eucharistic Prayer IV (it is actually my favorite one), and it tells the story of salvation.

The other six Eucharistic Prayers are the two Eucharistic Prayers for Reconciliation, used in Masses where the mystery of forgiveness is highlighted, and four Eucharistic Prayers for Various Needs and Occasions. These offer four distinct themes: The Church on the Way to Unity, God Guides the Church on the Way of Salvation, Jesus Way to the Father, and Jesus the Compassion of God.

The Catholic Church has many different Eucharistic Prayers because the richness of the Eucharist cannot be fully expressed through only one form of prayer. While every Eucharistic Prayer contains the same essential elements—thanksgiving, consecration, memorial of Christ's Passion and Resurrection, and intercessions—each prayer emphasizes different aspects of the mystery of salvation. The Church allows this variety to help the faithful enter more deeply into worship and better understand the many dimensions of the Eucharist.

The existence of multiple Eucharistic Prayers also reflects the universality of the Catholic Church. Catholics around the world share the same faith, yet the Church recognizes that different expressions of prayer can enrich worship. This diversity within unity demonstrates the beauty of Catholic tradition: many voices and forms joined together in one sacrifice of Christ offered at every Mass.

May the Lord bless you and keep you! May the Lord let His face shine upon you and be gracious to you! May the Lord look upon you kindly and give you peace! ~ Fr. Adam
