Dear Friends,

I have sad news to share with you this week:

Laura Kutscher, who has been our Director of Music for 7 ½ years, will be leaving that position after providing music at the Mass on July 4th. She has been a human dynamo since she began here setting up our music program to where it is today in the parish. Laura is a person of exceptional talent, both in music and in liturgy. I wholeheartedly believe she is the best Director of Music in the Archdiocese of Chicago, so as you can imagine, she will be greatly missed. Laura has personally played the piano and organ at most of our liturgical celebrations over the years... she has coordinated the musicians and cantors, developed and conducted choirs, researched appropriate music for each of our liturgies, helped plan liturgies, and coordinated the effort to enhance and update our sound system in church as well as the creation of our livestream service for the church and chapel.



When Pope Benedict XVI passed away recently, the Cardinal asked the six Bishop Vicars to celebrate a Mass in their Vicariate to pray for the Pope. Bishop Grob asked me if we could host that Mass at St. Theresa. Why us when there are 45 other parishes to choose from in this Vicariate? I believe a big part of that answer is because he knew that Laura would have been able to quickly put together that liturgy's music in such a way that it would have honored the memory of Pope Benedict. It was an exceptional liturgy that was organized in just a few days. I will not forget that experience and it speaks to me about why Laura is such a good music director.

Her work on key liturgical moments, like the Dedication Mass for the blessing of our new Adoration Chapel, Advent Missions, The Seven Last Words of Christ prayer on Good Friday and grand celebrations like Christmas and Easter will always be remembered by those who were there as a demonstration of how good music can be in a parish.

Laura will be moving back to her native state of Iowa, where she will be Director of Worship at Our Lady's Immaculate Heart Parish in Ankeny, a suburb of Des Moines. She has kindly organized musicians and music to cover our Masses until the beginning of September. I am very grateful for that.

Nicole Carlisle will also be leaving her position as Director of Communications for the parish by the end of July. Nicole has been working here for nine years, and during that time, she was tasked with creating the new role for us of Communications Director.

She creates a weekly parish bulletin that is a beacon of information for our parishioners. She coordinates the maintenance of the parish calendar. Nicole also created and maintains the Parish Website as well as utilizing communication vehicles such as Flocknote (which includes a weekly eNewsletter), Facebook, YouTube and other social media platforms. She has also advertised what is going on in the parish on a number of other different platforms. During the COVID pandemic and the shutdown that went with it, Nicole provided great care in making sure that everyone was kept up to date on what was going on in the parish. Her dedication to all of these projects is seen in the way people complimented the quality of these endeavors and always seem to know what is going on.

Nicole will be starting her new job with the Archdiocese of Chicago at the beginning of August. She will be the newly created Director of Priest Leadership Formation, working under Fr. Michael Knotek. She will be using her background in and experience in Adult Education to develop curricula for the priests of the Archdiocese of Chicago to support us as we lead in the post- Renew my Church time.

As Nicole is also a parishioner of St. Theresa, she will continue with her many voluntary roles within the parish, so we will still see her around a lot here, but she will be greatly missed as Communications Director.

Losing these two very valued ministers in the parish, as well as having Fr. Matt Jamesson begin his new assignment as Associate Pastor at St. Hubert/St. Matthew Parish this week is going to be very difficult, for all of us. I do wish to thank Laura, Nicole and Fr. Matt for all they have done in their many years of service to our spiritual home. What each of them has given to this parish over the years is remarkable. It is impossible to replace people of their quality, skill and faith, but we will do our best to find worthy successors to Laura and Nicole. Please pray for Laura, Nicole and Fr. Matt as they begin new chapters in their lives. Transitions like these are never easy, but I know they will provide great leadership to the new communities they will be serving... and those people will be much better for it.





Francesco Forgione, OFMCap (1887–1968), better known as Padre Pio, was an Italian Capuchin friar, priest, stigmatist, and mystic. He was beatified in 1999 and canonized in 2002 by Pope John Paul II. His body is exposed in a golden crypt in the sanctuary of Saint Pio of Pietrelcina, next to the convent of San Giovanni Rotondo, now a major pilgrimage site. Padre Pio is one of the world's most popular saints. He has become a special patron of the sick, as many healings have occurred through his intercession.

The U.S.-based Saint Pio Foundation continues to sponsor tours of the relics of Padre Pio in (arch)dioceses and parishes across North America. The majority of those attending the relics tour would never be able to travel to San Giovanni Rotondo or Pietrelcina to visit the places where the Saint was born, lived, and died.

The visitation of these relics allows the faithful to have a "spiritual encounter" with Padre Pio, to spend time in prayer, and to ask for his intercession.

The Relics of Padre Pio will be displayed for veneration at Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Naperville on Tuesday, July 11, 2023.

All are invited to venerate the relics from 9 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. The relics will be displayed near the altar, with pews reserved for silent prayer and devotion. Recitation of the Holy Rosary and talks on the life and intercession of Padre Pio will occur throughout the day. Devotional items and books will also be available for purchase. The day will conclude with a special Mass in honor of Padre Pio at 7 p.m. *See reverse for visitor and volunteer information*.

Make celebrations "highly joyful, lowly wasteful" by practicing zero-waste options for gatherings, such as picnics, BBQs and camping. Reusable items can add a touch of class while significantly reducing waste. Lightweight reusable plates, utensils, bowls, and cups can be borrowed from friends or purchased reasonably at second hand stores, along with cloth napkins, towels and table clothes.

Get creative with packaging, using reusable containers for party food and also for left-overs. Wipe food off when finished and use a washable cloth bag to hold used dinnerware for transport and dishwashing later. Reserve a bag for recyclables and a container for compostables. If you must use disposables, buy biodegradable paper products instead of plastic. Skipping water in plastic bottles, skipping balloons, confetti and fireworks will save money and keep the outdoors healthier for future celebrations!
