

Father Carl's Corner

This weekend, we celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ – Corpus Christi, a solemn and beautiful reminder of the central mystery of our faith - that Christ is truly present with us in the Eucharist. This is not just a symbol or a memory. It is Christ himself - His Body given for us, His Blood poured out for us, offered again and again at every Mass for the life of the world. For Catholics, the Eucharist is not just something we receive. It is someone we encounter. Jesus meets us in bread and wine, made sacred, and enters into our fragile, everyday lives. At a time when so much feels uncertain, when our world faces division, when families and communities experience change, when we face the reality of parish communities being united and now one of our worship sites being closed, the Eucharist grounds us. It reminds us that God is not distant. Christ walks with us, feeds us, and remains with us.



The Eucharist calls us to be Eucharistic people - people of gratitude, presence, and sacrifice. We are invited not only to receive Christ, but to become what we receive, His Body in the world today. That means carrying His peace into places of conflict, His compassion into suffering, and His hope into situations that seem hopeless. Even in uncertainty, the Eucharist assures us that God is with us, God is for us, and God will not abandon us.

Saint Thomas Aquinas once wrote, so beautifully, "The Eucharist is the Sacrament of Love; it signifies Love, it produces Love. The Eucharist is the consummation of the whole spiritual life."

How then do we live this out today? We begin with small acts - reaching out to a neighbor who is isolated, praying for those who suffer in silence, showing up for one another in times of grief or transition. We join our struggles with Christ's, offering them quietly at Mass. We let the Eucharist shape not only what we believe but how we treat others. When we do this, we become signs of God's presence for those in our community who are saddened and struggling with change and for our weary world.

As we receive the Body of Christ at any one of our sacred worship sites, and in a particular way today at Saint Catherine of Siena-Saint Lucy Church as we offer the closing Mass in this sacred space, let us become more fully the Body of Christ in our community and in the world. Together, even in uncertainty, let us find strength and hope, trusting we are held in the heart of God.





Corpus Christi - The Body (and Blood) of Christ

What does this mean for us as a Church? How do we live the life the Church asks of us?

The Church celebrates the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, or the Solemn Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, on Sunday, June 22. During this highest level of holiday, the Church adores Jesus Christ who is truly present, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity, in both forms of the Eucharist. One common form of celebrating holidays is parades. The Church has a history of hosting a sort of parade, called a Eucharistic Procession, on Corpus Christi.

Spirit & Light is planning a Eucharistic Procession during the weekend of Corpus Christi in (June) 2026. To help the Parishes prepare for this, over the next year, various resources will be made available to help us deepen our relationship with and love of Jesus truly present in the Eucharist. Soon-to-be canonized Bl. Carlo Acutis collected documentation of various Eucharistic Miracles and publicized it via a website and a travelling exhibit. Some of this exhibit will be found at each Oak Park worship site during June for you to read as you enter and leave the church. Each week will have different new material rotating through the worship sites. So be sure to look at them each week.

Being the Eucharist to All that We Meet

Luke 22:19-20 Jesus took the bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me." And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which will be shed for you."

Matthew 28: 19-20 "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you."

Jesus clearly commissions us to teach the world about His real presence in the Eucharist, bringing Him to all the nations. Have you ever wondered how to do this or what this looks like? Is this only something that we do at Mass? Do we just talk to people about Jesus and the Eucharist? This month, on Wednesday, June 25 at 7pm in McDonough Hall on St. Giles's campus, Sr. Julia Walsh, a Franciscan Sister of Perpetual Adoration, will speak to us about how we can be Eucharist to everyone we meet.

Sr. Julia holds a Masters in Pastoral Studies of the Catholic Theological Union and is a certified spiritual director. As part of her congregation's formation team, she serves women who are discerning their religious vocation. Sr. Julia hosts the Messy Jesus Business blog and podcast and is the author of For Love of the Broken Body: A Spiritual Memoir and the forthcoming 2026: A Book of Grace-Filled Days (Loyola Press). She is also a speaker, educator, retreat presenter, and avid podcaster, passionate about exploring the intersection of creativity, spirituality, activism, and community life.
