

Father Carl's Corner

You are either at Mass or streaming ... each is a good choice for keeping a strong mind and heart in today's world; however, in person is the most desired. In our world which is shaken by wars, hunger, violence, and a growing disregard for human life, it is easy to feel overwhelmed or even numb, as the headlines change daily, but the suffering seems constant.

In the midst of this chaos, we come to Mass, not as an escape, but as a return to the one thing that will never change – God. God does not shift with the times or bend to political or social trends. His love, justice, and mercy are constant. His word still speaks truth. His message still calls us to compassion, forgiveness, courage, and hope. Jesus



Christ remains the same yesterday, today and forever (Hebrews 13:8). In this truth, we find our anchor. Coming to Mass each week helps us to remember who we are and whose we are. It is not just a ritual, it is a re-centering of our hearts and minds. We listen again to the Gospel that calls us to love when the world tells us to fear, to forgive when the world pushes us to revenge, to serve when the world says to take.

So what should we remember? Though the world may change, drastically and often painfully – GOD DOES NOT END. And what should we pay attention to? The quiet voice of the spirit urging us to be agents of peace, to care for the poor, to defend life in all its stages, and to remain faithful even when it is difficult. Saint Teresa of Avila once said, "Christ has no body now but yours ... Yours are the eyes with which He looks with compassion on the world."

Keep showing up for Mass. Keep praying. Keep loving. That's how we live out the presence of God which never changes in the world around us. This week, let's each try to commit to one act of compassion; to visit someone who is lonely, check in on a neighbor or friend, reach out to someone struggling, or volunteer in some way. That's how we can live out His presence that never changes in a world that desperately needs more mercy, care, and love made visible.

The St. Edmund Choir rehearses three Wednesday evenings in Murphy Hall at St. Edmund and sings at the Saturday 5:00pm Mass three times each month. Our first rehearsal is Wednesday, September 10, from 7:00 - 8:30pm. New members in all voice parts are welcome!

The Choristers (our parish choir for children and youth) are for young people in grades 3-8. Choristers rehearse once each week on Tuesdays or Wednesdays depending on grade level. MIGRANT MINISTRY UPDATE: Pivoting again

As Father Carl announced in last week's announcements, it is not possible to retain the St. Edmund School Building. So, Migrant Ministry has once again been asked to pivot, to change directions. The Migrant Ministry Advisory Committee has decided that October 9 will be the final day for the Tuesday-Thursday Migrant Ministry Mornings. We are seeking places that might house this amazing program moving forward. This early closing will give the volunteers time to pack up and move all the clothing and furniture before it gets too cold inside the building.



In fact we have seen the needs of the migrants changing over the past few months. We expect that winter clothing will be needed, but other items may not. We are seeing a shift to the need for more services such as the Immigration Support Services. It will be moving across the street to Murphy Hall in early September. Mental health services, job training, and language programs are becoming a higher priority. Pivoting will become our motto over the next weeks.

We are working to develop a schedule for donations. There are a few items that we will continue to need. There will however be the need to reduce donations, and we are working to develop guidelines as we determine how we will move forward.






