



PREP & CHI RHO CONFIRMATION PROGRAM REGISTRATION FOR 2025 - 2026
begins WEDNESDAY, APRIL 9, 2025



Registration for the 2025-26 school year begins on Wednesday, April 9, 2025.

We meet for classes from September - April. Class dates will be available at registration and published on the parish website.

Registration can be completed **online, in person during regular business hours, or submitted via email**. The **online registration link** will be emailed to all families but **will not go live until April 9th**. Forms will also be available to download from the St. Mary of Vernon website starting on the 9th, and printed copies can be picked up from the PREP Office, Youth Ministry Office, Parish Office, or the Welcome Desk in the Church Narthex. If you are new to the ministry, please schedule an appointment so we can welcome you and give you the necessary information needed to register. If you have a child (3rd grade thru High School) with little or no religious education, please call to discuss placement. Also, please call if your child has been baptized in a faith other than the Roman Catholic tradition.

Most of our communication is done via email or text. Please be sure to include your cell phone number **and** your cell phone carrier on the registration form so we can add you to our notification list.

It is essential that you register as soon as possible. Notification of your child's enrollment will be sent via email **by the end of June and only after we have all of our catechists in place**.

Over the next few months, we will be putting together our volunteer roster for the 2025-2026 year. Just a reminder—Lead Catechists receive **free tuition and priority class placement**. 1. Our curriculum is spiral in nature and each year builds upon the lessons of the previous years. As a result, it is important that students complete each grade level. Please note that when you register, your child will be placed in the appropriately sequenced grade level.
2. Registration form must be filled out completely and signed including medical and insurance information for emergency.
3. Full payment is due with registration form. Special arrangements can be made, if needed. Contact the PREP or Youth Ministry Office for further details.
4. **All past due balances must paid in full**. Please contact the PREP/YM Offices if you have questions about your account.
5. We accept payment via **PushPay, checks, and cash**. Personal checks can be dropped off in person or mailed to the parish, attention **PREP or Youth Ministry Office**. If paying by **cash**, we kindly ask that you make the payment **in person**. For new students: a copy of their baptismal record if child not baptized at SMV and record of previous religious education should be submitted.
6. Regular consecutive in person attendance at Sunday masses and entirety of all class sessions is expected for all students. Parental participation is expected.




