



History of the Luminaria **ON PINE ST. SINCE 1981**



It all began when Renae McGovern befriended Dot Sheehan. Dot moved to the 400 block of South Pine Street from the state of Virginia. Dot had seen Luminaria there with milk jugs being used as candle holders. Dot was organizing her block (400 & invited the 500 block) to join her in lighting Luminaria on Christmas Eve of 1981. Renae asked if she

could join them in 1982 after witnessing the candle-lit milk jugs down our street.

In 1982, Renae organized the 500 block, as well as St. Mark Lutheran Church along Evergreen Ave. She also asked Rev. Loftus, pastor of St. Raymond Parish, if she could outline that block with the same Luminaria candle glow-ing effect. He said "yes" and often took it upon himself to light candles as he



walked around the block after inclement weather snuffed the candles out. Renae continued to organize with Dot Sheehan for 12 years.

Around 1993, Renae asked me to take on the Luminaria project. The 100 & 300 blocks came on board through the years and have grown to almost complete participation. There is a captain living on each of the five blocks. Candles are ordered from Monk Wine & Candle. They are the same ones used at St. Raymond Parish.


